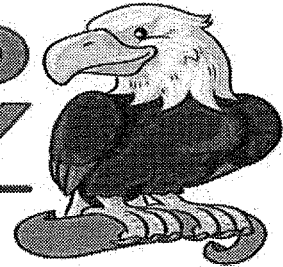

1. **Call to Order:** A meeting of the Dillard Elementary School SAC was held on Tuesday, May 26, 2026, at 3:00pm in the media center. The meeting was called to order at 3:15 p.m.
2. **Introductions and Attendance:** 22 people were present at the SAC meeting. 7 of the attendees were on the SAC committee.
3. **Approval or Correction of February 2026 meeting minutes:** A motion was made by Ms. Kelly to approve the April meeting minutes. Ms. Hodge second the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.
4. **Reports:**

**Principal Report:** Mrs. Robinson welcomed all stakeholders. She discussed FAST PM 3 data. In ELA 3<sup>rd</sup> grade scored 58% proficiency, 4<sup>th</sup> grade 48% proficiency, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade 43% proficiency. In math 3<sup>rd</sup> grade scored 64% proficiency, 4<sup>th</sup> grade 77% proficiency, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade 84% proficiency. In science 5<sup>th</sup> grade scored 60% proficiency. Learning gains in ELA were 56% overall and 71% in math. In primary ELA Kindergarten scored 39% proficiency, 1<sup>st</sup> grade scored 45% proficiency, and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade scored 26% proficiency. In math Kindergarten scored 57%, 1<sup>st</sup> grade 48%, and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade scored 34%. Ms. Robinson presented the budget for the next school year. She went over our projected enrollment, budget, projected allocations of funds, positions, and special programs such as ASD, Headstart, and VPK. We are a summer school site this summer. We will host 7 schools. We are also planning a academic/fitness camp for the summer through Ranger Good Works. Since 2<sup>nd</sup> grade data is extremely low Ms. Robinson wants to implement a 2<sup>nd</sup> grade summer program for reading instruction. However, we do not have enough

committee members present to vote on the use of accountability funds. We have \$13,682 in accountability funds.

There are no SESIR reports for the months of April at our school.





5. 26-27 – SIP Plan – Ms. Robinson discussed that primary reading is a concern for next year. Our upcoming third graders are lower than most schools in district. Next year we need to focus on primary reading and reading as a whole. The parents were given time to discuss goals for next year. Ms. Hodge suggested that our goal should be for all grade levels to be above 50% proficiency in ELA next year. Ms. Ashley stated that the SIP plan should could continue with the main focus of ELA for the 26-27 school year. Also, absences have improved this year, but tardiness is an issue that needs to be added to the SIP plan. We did not have enough SAC members to vote; therefore we will vote on our SIP goals the first meeting in August.
6. **Title 1 Updates** – No Title 1 updates at this time.



