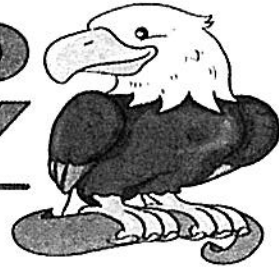

1. **Call to Order:** A meeting of the Dillard Elementary School SAC was held on Tuesday, September 25, 2025, at 5:00pm in the media center. Ms. Kelly called the meeting to order at 5:05pm.
2. **Introductions and Attendance:** 8 people were present at the SAC Meeting.
3. **Approval or Correction of May 2025 meeting minutes:** A motion was made by Ms. Hodges to approve the May meeting minutes. Ms. Allen second the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.
4. **Reports:**

Principal Report: Mrs. Robinson welcomed all stakeholders. She discussed the results of the FAST PM3. Our math scores were higher than the district and state average. Science went up almost 20 percentage points from last year. Ms. Robinson stated that we will have Dillard Day as a student incentive for increasing the school grade. We have many sponsors from the community to help with Dillard Day. The school is requesting \$6,000 from accountability funds for 3rd grade ELO camp. Over 60% of our 3rd grade students scored a level 1 or below on their 2nd grade end the year assessment. This year our focus will be reading. To continue to increase science scores we are asking for \$1,320.00 to purchase J and J Drill practice books in science. We tabled our vote for the use of the accountability funds until the next meeting. She discussed the Robotics Club kickoff and that we will be partnering with Nova Southeastern University for Robotics. Students from NSU will be coming in to support and teach Robotics. We have already started the Drumline, and gardening will be starting soon. There are no SESIR reports this year at our school. Accountability funds - \$15, 601.35

5. **SAC Bylaw** – Ms. Kelly read the SAC Bylaws, and we discussed that team members shall be elected for one year term and committee membership.
6. **2025-2026 SAC Committee** – Breonia McCall, Patricia Allen, and Tashara Hodges was voted in unanimously to be SAC Committee members for the 2025-26 school year. Mrs. Hodges doesn't want to continue as the SAF Chair. Patricia Allen was voted unanimously to take Mrs. Hodges place as the SAF chair. Ms. Kelly motioned that each of them be a part of SAC committee. Ms. McCall 2nd the motion.
7. **Adjourn** – Ms. Kelly made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mrs. Hodge second the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 5: 50pm.
