## School Advisory Council (SAC) Emergency Meeting Minutes

### 1. Call to Order

The emergency School Advisory Council (SAC) meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mr. Williams in the Blanche Ely High School Media Center.

### 2. Determination of Quorum

A quorum was established, allowing the council to conduct official business, motions, and voting.

### 3. Purpose of the Meeting

The purpose of the emergency meeting was to review, discuss, and approve School Recognition (A+ Funds) ballot options and to address time-sensitive allocations of SAC accountability funds.

### 4. School Recognition (A+ Funds) Discussion

The principal reviewed the School Recognition funding allocation. After required fringe benefits, \$140,176 was available for distribution. An additional \$5,485 from unspent prior-year School Recognition funds resulted in a total of \$145,511 reflected in the budget.

### 5. Action Taken – Discussion of suggested ideas for proposals of A+ Funds and creation of the ballot options

**Two ballot options were approved for staff voting:**

**Option 1: (proposed by Ms. Djuna Robinson, motion to approve by Ms. Connie McGirt, seconded by Mr. Tavures Williams)**

- Instructional staff: \$1,150
- Non-instructional staff: \$600
- Administrators: \$500



- Two school-assigned social workers: \$288 each

- Students: \$0

## **6. Additional Motions and Approvals**

- \$8,000 allocated to cover NCLEX-related exam costs for Practical Nursing students.
- \$8,000 allocated to support student participation in the HBCU College Tour.
- \$1,000 allocated to support the Girls Summit.

## **7. Announcements**

- A+ Funds ballot will be distributed to staff within three (3) days.



- Continued encouragement for student-centered proposals to be brought before SAC.
