

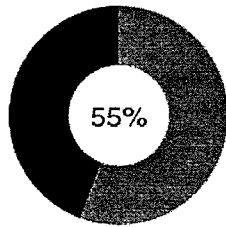

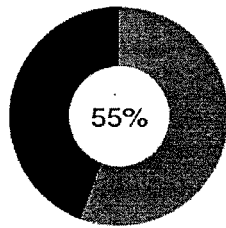

**Call to Order** -The meeting was called to order at 5:47 p.m. by chairperson Jeanie Jones. Ms. Jones asked attendees to sign in on the proper form.

**Minutes** – The minutes from the November meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Ms. Defoe and seconded by Ms. Taylor to accept the minutes as printed. The motion passed. We presently have a quorum.

**UPDATES**

a) **Principal's Update** – Ms. Scott shared with us that PM2 testing is taking place, the midterm exam schedule is December 16-19. Students will be dismissed early each day. We are currently in basketball season. December 7, at 4:00 p.m., "Soulful Celebrations" takes place. "The Chocolate Nutcracker." Will be performed December 13 and 14. Graduation takes place May 28, 2026, at Dillard High School.

b) **SESIR** – No report

c) **Accountability funds** -The balance in school accountability funds is \$22,362.69.

d) **Title I** – Ms. Rhue stated the Title I annual parent survey is open. We need at least 200 parents to complete the survey.

**SAF Update** – Ms. Taylor shared information from central and district advisory. She spoke of student services and telehealth, the Phoenix Declaration, and schools of hope.

**OLD BUSINESS** -None

**NEW BUSINESS** – Professional Study Day (PSD) Update – Ms. Scott reviewed with the group the reason for PSDs. So far this year the staff have participated in professional learning communities (PLC), professional development hosted by Dillard's administrators, as well as a field trip to Old Dillard Museum. We will address the waiver process at a later meeting.

Ms. Scott explained the school recognition program and Dillard 6-12's eligibility. Ms.

Jones reviewed the proposals submitted by the staff. \$160,000 was awarded, after fringe benefits the amount is approximately \$148,000. After a healthy discussion a motion was made by Ms. Davis and seconded by Ms. Hankerson-Harris to place the following choices on the ballot:

1. 100% of the recognition funds will be distributed to all full-time employees who worked 150 days or more during the 2024-25 school year, excluding administrators.
2. Funds will be distributed to all full-time employees, 60% instructional, 40% non-instructional who worked 150 days or more during the 2024-25 school year.
3. None of the above

The motion unanimously passed.

**ANNOUNCEMENTS** – Mr. Szoke stated he thoroughly enjoyed the staff field trip to the Old Dillard Museum, Ms. Cherolyn Davis was the organizer. A motion was made by Ms. Gooch and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to adjourn the meeting at 7:39 p.m. The next meeting will be held Wednesday, January 28, 2026, 5:30 p.m.

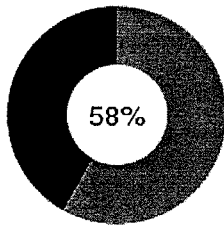

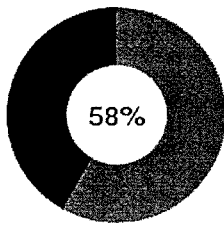

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Florida School Recognition Program (A+ Funds) Proposals. Staff must have worked at least 75% of employees contracted calendar.

The motion passed.

Ms. Defoe wanted the minutes to reflect she felt some funds for students should have been set aside. She also asked how Title I funds were being utilized. Mr. Broomfield stated he would address that at the next meeting, He also talked about the freeze on funding, as well as facility usage and rentals. Desman will seek feedback from his peers regarding student needs.

A motion was made by Allison Hankerson-Harris and seconded by Regina Rhue to adjourn the meeting at 6:31 p.m. The motion passed.

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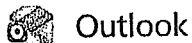


