






Call to Order -The meeting was called to order at 5:53 p.m. by chairperson Jeanie Jones. Ms. Jones asked attendees to sign in on the proper form. We do not have a quorum.

Minutes – The minutes from the February meeting were reviewed with one correction, change January to February in the heading.

UPDATES

a) **Principal's Update** – Ms. Scott reported on Mr. Broomfield's behalf that there is currently \$17,041 in the school's accountability budget. There was no SESIR report. There is a schoolwide push to celebrate scholars level 3 and higher. The theme is "Bringing Back the 90's" with music, iconic candy (now and later). The schoolwide SAT and PM3 are upcoming.

b) **Title I** – Ms. Rhue informed us that we are 88% in compliance with our e-binder. A Virtual Curriculum Night will be held next Wednesday via zoom. Ms. Rhue reviewed the School Improvement Plan with Title I

c) SAF Presentation – Ms. Iyinka Jones introduced our speaker for the evening, Dr. Mistoria Brown. Dr. Brown is the current president of Dillard’s alumni association, founder of the company 1907, and works with Dillard’s Black Student Union BSU. She shared her story, BSU's upcoming speaker series, as well as the crossover program for graduating seniors in the spring. Ms. Broady is the faculty member working with the BSU.

OLD BUSINESS – Professional Study Days and PSD Continuation Waiver and Intent to Apply. We have completed the process; the faculty will vote next week.

NEW BUSINESS-Funding Requests -The SigmaC@T Robotics Team under the leadership of Mr. Steve Szoke is requesting \$5000 to fund robot build materials for the FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) competition. Our team is the oldest running team in the state of Florida. The students gave an exemplary presentation. There were many in the audience interested in student sponsorships. We did not have a quorum so voting will have to take place at the next meeting.

ANNOUNCEMENTS- Ms. Bell wanted the group to know that former student representative Andrew Griffiths was very passionate about having a black student union in force at Dillard before he graduated. He and his mom Marlene Mitchell, worked tirelessly to make it happen. Andrew is currently attending Florida A&M University. The meeting was adjourned at 7:23 pm. The next meeting will take place Wednesday, April 1, 2026
