Call to Order -The meeting was called to order at 5:40 p.m. by chairperson Jeanie Jones. Ms. Jones asked the group to sign in on the proper form.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Florida School Recognition Program (A+ Funds) Proposals. Mr. Broomfield stated the district has a total of 221 staff members for Dillard 6-12 for the 2024-25 school year. Of that number, approximately 170 or 171 were present for 75% of the school year. After some discussion a motion was made by Mr., Broomfield and seconded by Ms. Hankerson-Harris for the following to be submitted for a faculty and staff vote:

- a) 100% of the funds (minus fringe) will be used for a one-time bonus to be divided equally amongst all the faculty and staff on the 2024-2025 roster including but not limited to security personnel, facility personnel, clerical, school administration, teachers, and cafeteria staff. Staff must have worked at least 75% of employees contracted calendar.
- b) None of the above

The motion passed.

Ms. Defoe wanted the minutes to reflect she felt some funds for students should have been set aside. She also asked how Title I funds were being utilized. Mr. Broomfield stated he would address that at the next meeting, He also talked about the freeze on funding, as well as facility usage and rentals. Desman will seek feedback from his peers regarding student needs.

A motion was made by Allison Hankerson-Harris and seconded by Regina Rhue to adjourn the meeting at 6:31 p.m. The motion passed.
