


Call to Order -The meeting was called to order at 5:55 p.m. by chairperson Jeanie Jones. Ms. Jones asked attendees to sign-in on the proper form. Mr. Szoke, Ms. Rhue and Ms. Simmons were unable to attend this evening. We currently do not have a quorum. The meeting will be for information purposes.

Minutes – The minutes from the February 5 meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Ms. Giannini and seconded by Ms. Simmons to accept the minutes with the needed correction. The motion passed.

UPDATES

- a) **Principal's Update** – Mr. Broomfield reported FAST writing started today, April 2 PM3 reading begins in May. ELO takes place during school and leveling up on Saturdays. He is looking for ideas to celebrate the success of level 3,4, and 5 students. The University of Florida will offer an on-line course in the fall entitled, "Happiness." Course selections will be taking place. There will be prescribed pathways and a revamping of Cambridge. We briefly discussed the backlog of work orders. We also discussed ways to extend our reach so people will know the great things taking place at Dillard.
- b) **SESIR** – There were 24 infractions in February. We briefly discussed the incident that made the press.
- c) **Accountability funds** -The balance in school accountability funds is \$17,938.56. **d) Title I** – Ms. Jones reported per Ms. Rhue, we are 100% compliant with our Title I documents. We are also the first school to complete them.
