Call to Order -The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m. by chairperson Jeanie Jones. Ms. Jones asked attendees to sign in on the proper form.

Minutes – A motion was made by Ms. Taylor and seconded by Ms. Defoe to accept the minutes with the following corrections: Change the balance in the school accountability funds to \$10,385.75, change the graduation date from June 8 to May 28, correct spelling of Stephon to “Stephun.” The motion passed.

UPDATES

- a) **Principal’s Update** – Mr. Broomfield stated that our district is currently in a crisis with the budget. There are many schools still working on working on their budgets. As it stands, our current allocation for the 26-27 school year is 366 sections of which we currently have 535. That means we are slated for 61 positions, not people. We will lose 21 positions. The district will now be taking care of the grounds for the school. We are currently in our testing phase. We are currently at 44% proficiency in ELA. Our goal is to achieve an “A”. Senior Awards night and Top 10% take place May 14. The Crossover Ceremony takes place May 16.
