Minutes

October 1, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 5:45 p.m. by chair Dee Defoe. Ms. Defoe welcomed the group. The minutes from the September meeting will be tabled until November. Ms. Defoe shared information from both the district and central area advisory council meetings. Superintendent Hepburn shared that enrollment is down across the district, charter schools as well. The district is presently not accepting any new hires, internal hires only. "Reclaiming our Schools," thirty-four (34) schools are currently under review. A discussion was held on vape detectors. The "I Need Help", active lockdown badge was discussed.

Veda Hudge from the School Transformation department explained her role and the roll of her department. They currently serve 21 schools, 16 of them are in the central area. Dr. Toomer was also present. A discussion was held on whether students are required to get on social media apps. Schools are now able to update their pages. Principals have access to the calendar. Policy 1070 was discussed. A flyer was made available to submit school related concerns through BCPS CARES. Time was given for questions and concerns.

The next meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 5, 5:30 p.m. The next District Advisory meeting takes place October 8, 2025, at 6:15 at KCW. The next Central Area Advisory meeting will be held October 15, 2025, 6:15 p.m. at Indian Ridge Middle School. A motion was made by Kimiko Gooch and seconded by Tracey Clark-Graham to adjourn the meeting at 6:22 p.m.
