Call to Order -The meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m. by Jeanie Jones. Ms. Jones asked attendees to sign-in on the proper form.

Minutes - The minutes of the May meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Ms. Defoe and seconded by Ms. Taylor to accept the minutes as printed. The motion passed.

UPDATES

a) Principal's Update – Mr. Broomfield stated each school receives \$5.00 per pupil for the prior year's enrollment. Dillard currently has 140 students' less than last year. Broward County operates under school-wide averages. As budget conferences take place there may be a need to cut positions. He shared slides of the school's vision and focus, the school improvement plan goals, directives and behavior expectations. CONGRATULATIONS!!! Dillard 6-12 is a "B" school, just one point away from an "A." The bar has been raised for this year. The focus will be on the lowest 25 percentile and learning gains. Students are wearing their ID's. We need them in school on time and to have the teacher's take accurate attendance. There is a new emergency response system (badge) being used at all schools. There is a new school website, it is currently being updated by staff downtown. Dillard hosted the National Football Showcase. Dillard will also host the superintendents Redefining Our Schools meeting on September 18.

b)SESIR - No report at this time.

c)Accountability funds -The balance in school accountability funds is \$0

d)Title I - Ms. Rhue stated she needs 75% of the parent-student compacts to be returned. We are on track with Title I.

NEW BUSINESS – SAC Chair vote – Ms. Scott stated after polling the staff to ascertain interest in the SAC chair position, we are pleased to unanimously welcome back Ms. Jeanie Jones as chair.
