- IV. Review of Agenda and Minutes
 - Minutes from the previous meeting were included in the email. Minutes have been approved.
- V. Old Business

- VI. School Accountability Funds
 - Current balance \$11,400, but voting for some is pending, waiting for approval.
- VII. New Business
 - The topic of school recognition funds allocation from the previous meeting which pertained to a vote approving \$5000 to be used for scholars and \$5000 for teachers' incentives was revisited. The committee specified what the approved amount of \$5000 for student incentive would be used towards. A purchase of a library vending machine to promote literacy and 4 chairs.
 - The school Recognition Funds of \$8000 that was voted last SAC meeting for 5th grade field trip was not approved. School recognition funds should be used for the betterment of all scholars. Approximately \$16000 is still left from School Recognition Funds. We have asked the committee and staff to give proposals or suggestions specifying how those funds should be spent to discuss and vote at our next SAC meeting, April 1st.
