V. Redefining Our Schools – Mrs. Lizbeth Torres

Mrs. Torres reviewed updates regarding the 2026–2027 school year transition.

Teacher Contractual Hours

- New contractual hours: **6:55 AM – 4:17 PM**
- Due to four instructional days, required hours will be absorbed Monday–Thursday.

Student Schedule Updates

- Passing periods will be **5 minutes**
- Class periods will be approximately **114 minutes** each
- Students will attend **4 classes per day**

Student Grandfathering

All current Hallandale High School students (Grades 9–11) are grandfathered and may remain enrolled regardless of residence changes.

Transportation Concerns

- Ongoing issues reported with the **Register to Ride** system, especially impacting West Park students.
- District has been notified and is actively working on solutions.

Campus Improvements

Ongoing beautification and facilities upgrades include:

- Additional district work orders in progress

Important Budget Notes

- Budget projections are based on **student enrollment numbers**.
- Staffing and services are determined by **positions**, not individuals.

- Budget increases or reductions may impact personnel allocations and services.

ESE Allocation Information

- Higher ESE values indicate increased student support services needs (speech, occupational therapy, support facilitation, etc.).

Projected Departmental Allocations

Projected staffing reviewed included:

- Physical Education: 2
- Band: 1
- Yearbook: 1
- Foreign Language: 2
- Media Specialist: 1
- SBE Program: 3
- Deferment Program: 1
- ESE Specialist: 1
- ESE Teachers: 4
- Support Facilitators: 2

Instructional Coaching

- No Math or Science Instructional Coaches currently projected
- School would like to add these positions in the future

Clerical & Support Staff

Projected allocations include:

- 1 Office Manager
- 1 IMT
- 1 Registrar
- 3 General Clerks
- 3 ESE Teacher Assistants

School Accountability Funds

- State projections for accountability funds had not yet been released at the time of the meeting.

VIII. School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) Update

Mr. Forbes reported:

- No updated changes since the previous report
- April incidents remain at **17 total reported incidents**

IX. Area of Focus – School Improvement Plan Monitoring & Stakeholder Feedback – Mr. Forbes

ELA Focus Area

As required by the District, Hallandale High School continues focusing on ELA/Reading proficiency.

FAST PM3 Preliminary Data

- Preliminary proficiency data estimated at approximately **40–41% before disaggregation**
- Last year's proficiency increased from **38% to 44% after disaggregation adjustments**

Learning Gains

- Overall learning gains currently, approximately **56%**, consistent with the previous school year

Areas of Concern

- Lower quartile learning gains remain an area requiring additional focus

- Students struggled particularly with:
 - Myths
 - Shakespeare
 - Poetry analysis

Instructional Adjustments

Plans for next year include:

- Revised stamina days
- Additional interventions for lower quartile students
- District-created instructional focus calendars
- Earlier integration of Shakespeare instruction (Quarter 2)

Outlook

Administration and instructional teams remain optimistic regarding final proficiency outcomes after full disaggregation.

X. Department Updates

Science – Mrs. Kinlocke

- Biology EOC preliminary pass rate: **55%**
- Environmental Science teachers are preparing Biology curriculum for next school year
- Health Science lessons are currently being taught
- Opt-out letters distributed to parents

Literacy/Reading – Ms. Harris

- Final exams currently being prepared:
 - Read 180 Finals
 - ACT Prep Finals for retake students

Senior Graduation Progress

- Reading retake students reduced from approximately **120 students to 4 students**
- Awaiting additional CLT results
- Approximately **70 juniors** still need reading graduation requirements for next year

Additional Recognition

- Mentoring Tomorrow's Leaders (MTL) celebration will be held at Padrino's alongside Top 10% Dinner
- Reading teachers recognized for significant student progress

Social Studies – Ms. Freeman / Mrs. Torres

- U.S. History EOC preliminary proficiency: approximately **71%**
- Goal was 80%
- Staff praised for continued improvement and strong instructional efforts

Mathematics – Ms. Moreno

No additional updates provided.

CTE (Career & Technical Education) – Mrs. Sherman

- Additional industry certification testing completed
- Approximately **30 additional certifications earned** recently

Industry Certification Highlights

- CMAA Exam:
 - 11 students passed

Acceleration Rate

- Current acceleration rate: approximately **68%**
- Represents approximately **10% growth over last year**
- Goal remains **70%**

ELA – Mr. Forbes

- Recognition given to staff for strong testing season support and student participation

Testing Updates

- Algebra I EOC scheduled for **Wednesday, May 20, 2026**
- Approximately **349 students** scheduled to test

Testing Environment Improvements

- Reduced testing infractions and cheating incidents noted due to:
 - Increased monitoring
 - Active proctoring
 - Staff vigilance

Chargers' Future Club / Cultural Committee – Dr. Jacques

- Haitian Flag Day Celebration held in the Media Center
- Event included:
 - Cultural activities
 - Student participation across grade levels
 - ESE student involvement
 - Dance and educational presentations
- Event was highly successful and may become an annual tradition.
