 - a. Main Campus (High School and Middle School)
 - a. Ms. Morris
 - i. Our average daily attendance has increased.
 - ii. Our CTE acceleration total has gone up by 10% since last year.
 - iii. We have an alternative high school program in the evening from 4:30 – 9:30 for student that have difficulty attending school during the day.
 - iv. The middle school honor roll assembly went well. There is also a competition among homeroom teachers to see which has the highest assessments scores after testing.
 - v. Middle school has a mentoring program that assists students with managing their emotions and the various situations they encounter in a more positive way.
 - vi. We are planning a field trip for the middle school students that are on the A/B honor roll and those who have met or are close to proficiency on the FAST PM1 and PM2.
 - vii. Whiddon Rogers graduation rate has increased by 20%.
 - b. DJJ Report
 - a. Ms. Tapper spoke on behalf of Ms. S. Smith
 - i. We have 223-night school co-enrolled students.
 - ii. We have 70 students at the Plantation HS OCLC and 45 students at the Hollywood HS OCLC.
 - iii. We have been approved for 2 yoga sessions.

- c. Workforce Programs
 - a. Ms. Hucey spoke on behalf of Mrs. Savage
 - i. The adult ESOL enrollment numbers have been fluctuating. We have 22 students on roster.
 - ii. Mr. Howard informed the committee that we are looking into offering an online ESOL program.
 - iii. Ms. Morris spoke on behalf of Mrs. Savage regarding the improved BSO GED graduation numbers.
 - d. SESIR Updates – Mr. Schubert, speaking on behalf of Mr. Larose, informed the committee that there were 11 SESIR events in December and 16 SESIR events in January.

IX. New Business

- a. 30 CLT for students who have not met the graduation requirements – Ms. Morris requested \$1035.00 towards the purchase of 30 CLT tests for juniors and seniors that have not met their testing requirements. Ms. Thompson made a motion to approve the funds. Santiago Moreno-Gonzalez seconded the motion. The floor was opened for discussion. A vote was taken, a quorum of 9 members was present, and the vote passed.
- b. Purchase of 100 lunch containers for Women of Elegance Event – Ms. Chamberlain requested \$685.90 for 100 professional navy-blue food containers for Women of Elegance students. Mr. Schubert made a motion to approve the funds. Ms. Maharaj seconded the motion. The floor was opened for discussion. A vote was taken, a quorum of 9 members was present, and the vote passed.
- c. Banners for Adult ESOL Program – Ms. Elistin requested \$1005.48 from SAC towards the purchase of banners and signs promoting the Adult ESOL program throughout the community. However, Mr. Howard committed his own funds to purchase them for the program.
- d. Current Accountability Funds Balance - \$5386.98
