- A meeting of the Oakridge Elementary School Advisory Council was held in person on February 3, 2026. Mrs. Davis called the meeting to order at 5:31. Mrs. Davis will take the minutes for today's meeting. December's SAC minutes were reviewed and approved. Ms. Maria motioned to approve the minutes. Ms. Donald seconded the motion. Mrs. Davis reviewed the goals of Oakridge and SAC- Increase student achievement, dive deeper into curriculum, improve academic strategies for ALL students, and increase community engagement.

- a. Ms. Pinder reviewed our current FAST PM2 ELA and Math data, noting that overall proficiency is presently at 25% and 17%. She also shared comparative data reflecting the growth our students have made from last year's FAST PM2 administration to the current school year.

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Oakridge Elementary School Advisory Council was held in person on December 2, 2025. Mrs. Davis called the meeting to order at 5:35. Mrs. Davis reviewed the goals of Oakridge and SAC – Increase student achievement, diver deeper into curriculum, improve academic strategies for ALL students, and increase community engagement.

Old Business:

1. Accountability Funds
 - a. Accountability Fund - \$5,069.30
 - b. School Recognition \$9,452.00

New Business:

1. Motions
 - a. Game Truck – Mrs. Davis made a proposal to reward the students that score a level 3, 4, 5 on PM2 with a game truck experience. The allowed cost of the game truck is up to but not to exceed \$750. Ms. Smart made a motion to approve. Ms. Alexander seconded the motion, and all composition members were in favor. Monies come from the accountability fund.
 - b. An amendment was proposed to the approved motion from October for Kindergarten seat sacks. The original approved motion was for a purchase of \$239.60. The proposed amendment is to increase the amount to \$685.51 to order seat sacks for both K classes. Ms. Alexander made a motion to approve the amendment. Ms. Smart seconded the motion, and all composition members were in favor. Monies come from the accountability fund.
 - c. Incentives – Ms. Pinder proposed using School Recognition funds to fund 2 student activities. The amount cannot exceed \$500. Mrs. Davis made a motion to approve the request, and Ms. Aramboles seconded the motion. All composition members were in favor.

 - a. Oakridge is on the calendar to be repainted soon. The exterior of the campus will be repainted using cream, green, and gold accents. It will be a 4–5-month process.
