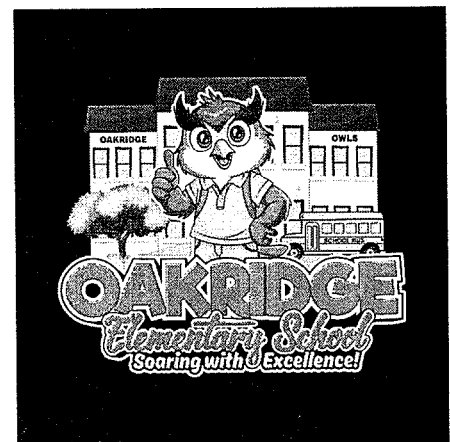

Meeting Minutes – April 28, 2026

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## Call to Order:

- A meeting of the Oakridge Elementary School Advisory Council was held in person on April 28, 2026. Mrs. Davis called the meeting to order at 5:30. Mrs. Davis will take the minutes for today's meeting. March SAC minutes were reviewed and approved. Ms. Vreeland motioned to approve the minutes. Ms. White seconded the motion. Mrs. Davis reviewed the goals of Oakridge and SAC- Increase student achievement, dive deeper into curriculum, improve academic strategies for ALL students, and increase community engagement.

## Old Business:

1. Accountability Funds
  - a. Accountability Fund - \$5,069.30
  - b. School Recognition \$9,452.00
2. Ms. Pinder also reminded parents about the 2026 BCPS customer service survey for families. The window will end on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

## New Business:

1. Motions: Ms. Pinder requested \$5,000 from the School Recognition Fund for student incentives and an additional \$3,000 from the Accountability Fund for supplemental student materials. Ms. Davis motioned to approve the request for the funds, and Mrs. White seconded the motion.
2. Ms. Pinder also shared information regarding the 21st Century Summer Program at Oakridge Elementary School. The program will run from June 8th through July 10th, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and will service students in grades 1st through 4th this summer.

## Principal's Report:

- School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR)- Ms. Pinder reported that there were zero incidents for SESIR.
- Ms. Pinder shared information regarding the scheduled for upcoming FA.S.T. PM3 assessments. Grades K-2 She reviewed the testing schedule; Grades 3–5 Reading, which will take place May 13th–15th. Grades 3–5 Math testing will take place on May 19<sup>th</sup>–21st, and Grade 5 Science State Assessment will be administered on May 21st.
- In addition, Ms. Pinder shared that students demonstrating proficiency and learning gains will be recognized with incentives upon the conclusion of testing.

## Principal's Report-

- School Accountability Funds: The school accountability funds amount is \$5,069.30.
- School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR)- Ms. Pinder reported that there were zero incidents for SESIR.
- Ms. Pinder shared information about the Annual Parent, Teacher, and Student Customer Survey. The window will open on March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026, and closes on May 15<sup>th</sup>. She shared this year that Parent Permission Refusal Form will be sent home. The form only needs to be signed and returned if parents would not like their student to complete the student customer survey. The percentage goals for student surveys needed is 40%, percentage goals for parents' surveys needed is 20%, percentage goals for staff surveys needed is 60%. The link to access the survey has been sent out and also posted on the school's website. The QR codes are available in the front office and will also be sent through electronic communication. Parents can grab a copy and scan the QR with a cell phone to complete the survey.

## Title One Updates

- Ms. Salazar discussed the purpose of the survey and reviewed the results.
- The results suggested communication was a strength, resources to help child on state test was a weakness.
- Parents were given a copy of the results to be able to use the data to guide the development of the PFEP and Parental Compacts.
- Parental Input was solicited on the results. Parents made no additional or concerns were made.
- No additional input was provided regarding the 2026-2027 Parental Engagement Survey. Review and Develop Parent and Family Engagement **(E4)**
- The current plan was reviewed.
- Ms. Salazar introduced the PFEP for the upcoming school year.

- The floor was open, and parents were given the opportunity to provide input on the plan and give suggestions or activities they would like to see happen.
- No suggestions were given.
