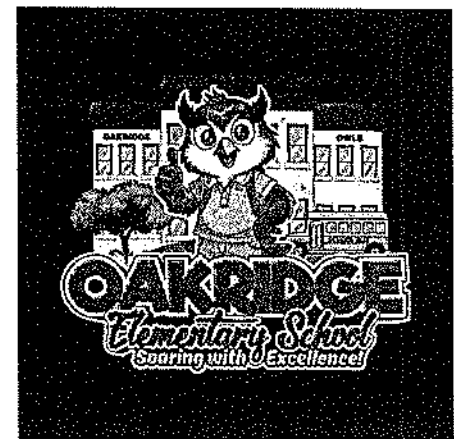

Call to Order:

1. Motions:










