SAC Minutes – December 2, 2025

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Oakridge Elementary School Advisory Council was held in person on December 2, 2025. Mrs. Davis called the meeting to order at 5:35. Ms. Moore will take the minutes for today's meeting. Mrs. Davis reviewed the goals of Oakridge and SAC – Increase student achievement, diver deeper into curriculum, improve academic strategies for ALL students, and increase community engagement.

Old Business:

1. Accountability Funds
 - a. Accountability Fund - \$5,069.30
 - b. School Recognition \$9,452.00

New Business:

1. Motions
 - a. Game Truck – Mrs. Davis made a proposal to reward the students that score a level 3, 4, 5 on PM2 with a game truck experience. The allowed cost of the game truck is up to but not to exceed \$750. Ms. Smart made a motion to approve. Ms. Alexander seconded the motion, and all composition members were in favor. Monies come from the accountability fund.
 - b. An amendment was proposed to the approved motion from October for Kindergarten seat sacks. The original approved motion was for a purchase of \$239.60. The proposed amendment is to increase the amount to \$685.51 to order seat sacks for both K classes. Ms. Alexander made a motion to approve the amendment. Ms. Smart seconded the motion, and all composition members were in favor. Monies come from the accountability fund.
 - c. Incentives – Ms. Pinder proposed using School Recognition funds to fund 2 student activities. The amount cannot exceed \$500. Mrs. Davis made a motion to approve the request, and Ms. Arambales seconded the motion. All composition members were in favor.

 - a. Oakridge is on the calendar to be repainted soon. The exterior of the campus will be repainted using cream, green, and gold accents. It will be a 4–5-month process.








Motion: Mrs. Davis motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:25pm. Motion carried unanimously.


