### School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes February 24, 2026

Welcome & Introductions

Dr. Hassad, SAC chairperson, called the meeting to order at 5:06 pm. Committee members introduced themselves.

Approval of Minutes- January 27, 2025: Dr. Hassad asked members to review minutes. Ms. Bures made a motion to approve minutes. This was seconded by Ms. Mizell. All members voted to approve minutes.

Principal's Report

School Accountability Funds - \$3998.50 for supplies and \$2924.55 for instructional materials. Ms. Giancarli, Principal asked SAC for \$2924.55 to purchase awards and spend on Extend Learning Opportunities. Mr. Greg made a motion to approve funds requested. Ms. Bures seconded the motion. All SAC members voted unanimously to approve funds.

A request to use the remaining \$3998.50 will be made at the SAC meeting in March. All orders have to be placed before April.

Principal Giancarli reported that there are 560 students currently enrolled at Olsen Middle.

The school hours will be changed next school year. Olsen Middle will start at a later time. The board will vote on this in April.

5<sup>th</sup> graders from elementary schools will be visiting Olsen Middle in March.

## SAC Updates-Mid Year Reflection-

Leadership team has completed and submitted the mid-year reflection.

Curriculum updates. Principal Giancarli presented midyear data. From PM 1 to PM 2 6<sup>th</sup> grade students 2.1% in Reading and 6.1 % in Math. 7<sup>th</sup> grade students dropped 1.5 % in Reading and made an increase of 16. 5% in Math. 8<sup>th</sup> grade students made an increase of 7 % in Reading and 0.7% in math. Overall there was a 2.8 percent increase in Reading and 8.6% in Math. Even though there was an increase, there is much more work to be done if we want to earn an A grade.

## Title I Updates

Dr. Hassad, Title I liaison, presented the results of the title I Parent Survey. 114 parents participated in the survey. Every SAC member was given a copy of the results. As can be seen from results, strong points included strong home school-home communication, parents know how to contact teachers, the school environment is very welcoming, and there is strong parent support at home with homework.

Areas for improvement include low participation at Title 1 Annual Meeting, low participation in Title I trainings, district and state resources underutilized, and parent input about what to teach the child was not requested by school.

Dr. Hassad explained that based on survey results, some documents need to be reviewed for the next school year. The first document reviewed was the School Parent Compact. Parents were given a copy of the current year's compact and asked to provide input. Ms. Bures wanted to know if the times for parent conferences, given that there is a proposal to change school hours. Principal Giancarli said the days for conferences will remain the same but the time may be adjusted based on the new hours. Ms. Mizell suggested that accessing FOCUS should be included under parent responsibilities. All members agreed. Accessing FOCUS will be included under parent responsibilities.

Dr. Hassad asked for parents to review the Parent Engagement Plan and give input based on the survey results and programs and activities that were included in this year's plan. Ms. Bures suggested that parent training on resources and FOCUS should be held more than once every year since we are always enrolling new Students. All parents agreed. Principal Giancarli said that this will be included in next year's Parent and Family Engagement Plan.

School Improvement Plan with Title I Addendum/Parents were asked to give input for next school year's plan-2026-2027.

One parent said that since there has been some improvement in results from PM 1 and PM 2, the SIP with Title I addendum should remain the same. All stakeholders agreed. SIP

will remain as is for 2026-2027-school year.

2026-2027 Parent Allocation

Dr. Hassad explained to parents that all refreshments/food is provided by money Title I. This year, we received \$1100 which was spent on refreshments for ESOL/ESE Parent Night, Literacy Nigh, Math Night, Civic Night, and Parent Night training on digital resources. She asked all stakeholders for additional input on how this allocation should be spent. Parents and other stakeholders agreed that this allocation should be used the same way next year.

Unified dress code. Principal Giancarli told attendees that Olsen will push through with another effort to get parents to vote for a unified dress. Last year, 82% of parents who voted but only 61% voted in favor of a dress code. We need 67 and 2/3 % votes for uniforms to be implemented.

Open Agenda: We are proud to announce that we have been designated Magnet School of Excellence. Thanks to the magnet coordinator, Ms. Harris.
