Dr. Hassad, SAC chairperson, called the meeting to order at 5:06 pm. Committee members introduced themselves.

Unified dress code. Olsen will push through with another effort to get parents to vote for a unified dress. Last year, of the 82% of parents who voted, only 61% voted in favor of a dress code. We need 67 and 2/3 % votes for us to implement uniforms.


