Welcome & Introductions

Dr. Hassad, SAC chairperson, called the meeting to order at 5:06 pm. Committee members introduced themselves.

Approval of Minutes- February 2026: Dr. Hassad asked members to review minutes. Ms. Babok made a motion to approve minutes. This was seconded by Ms. Bures. All members voted to approve minutes.

School Accountability Funds - \$3998.50 for supplies and \$2924.55 for instructional materials. Dr. Hassad requested \$2924.55 to purchase supplies for a Maker Space in the Media center and to upgrade the Game Room. Ms. Bures made a motion to approve spending funds; seconded by Mr. Smart. All members voted to approve spending funds on Maker Space and Game Room.

Curriculum updates. Principal Giancarli reported that students are currently taking the PM 3 Writing test. Small groups tested today, whole classes will be testing tomorrow, and make-ups will be done on Thursday. The testing window is

very short.

There is a possibility that school will start later next school year. We start at 7:05 Am but there are suggestions for a later start, possibly 8:00 am. The school board will vote in April.

Our current enrollment is 557 students. This current school year were projected to have 571 students but next school year we are projected to have 521 students.

We will not have a registrar next school year. This position will be cut.

Title I Updates

Title I binder is 100% complete. We have all proposed parent meetings for this year except one. Tonight is Math Parent Night.

Unified dress code. Olsen will push through with another effort to get parents to vote for a unified dress. Last year, of the 82% of parents who voted, only 61% voted in favor of a dress code. We need 67 and 2/3 % votes for us to implement uniforms. So far, we have over 300 positive votes. It is likely that the required number of votes will be met Parents will be notified before the end of this school year.

Open Agenda: We are proud to announce that we have been designated Magnet School of Excellence. Thanks to the magnet coordinator, Ms. Harris.

Adjournment: Ms. Bures made a motion to adjourn meeting, seconded by Ms. Santos. Meeting was adjourned at 5:55 pm.






