I. Welcome & Call to Order	The meeting was called to order at 2:20 p.m. by Ms. Kia Moore, SAC Chairperson.
II. Review of January 2026 Minutes	Ms. Kia Moore reviewed the minutes of January’s meeting. There were no corrections to the minutes. The Motion to Approve the Minutes was done by Ms. Britney Wright and seconded by Ms. Reynolds.
III. School Accountability Funds Vote	<p>Attendees voted on ways to spend the \$22,801 in the School Accountability Fund. Below are agreed upon ways voted on in order of priority:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Moving Up Promotion Ceremonies: caps, gowns, tassels, sashes, and certificates students, retractable banner, two blue-tooth speakers, cotton candy machine with sugar and paper, tablecloths, child friendly bookcase, and school spirit t-shirts for students.</li> <li>- Buzzer for the door in the main office</li> <li>- Sensory Room Items: Textured Wall items, Sensory Manipulatives, Sensory Tent, Light Filters. Ms. Freeman recommended selecting Lakeshore as the vendor due to the established business relationship and their capability to assemble items purchased from their store.</li> <li>- Family Resource Hub: signage, door coverings, and graphics</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Initially, parents suggested that the most important thing on the list should be updating the playground. 	<p>Freeman explained that the playground would come from capital funds. It will cost about \$150,000 for labor and materials to restore it. A request was submitted to update the playground for our current population of Preschool students, so that the school could allocate accountability funds for other purposes.</p>
<p>IV. School Improvement Pan SIP</p>	<p>Assistant Principal, Ms. Powell stated that our school’s goal for this academic year is to enhance Pre-K students’ foundational literacy skills. She reviewed the mid-year summary. She shared the challenges that we faced being a new Early Learning Center. Helping teachers understand the new curriculum is also challenging, however, this is addressed during professional learnings and weekly planning sessions. The strengths of our school are teachers’ participation in Professional Development, Professional Learning Communities, and parents’ engagement during Welcome Wednesdays.</p>
<p>V. School Environment Safety Incident Report (SESIR)</p>	<p>Ms. Powell shared that we had one incident which was reported to the State. Ms. Freeman described the incident as a prohibited item used for adult recreational purposes that fell out of a student’s bookbag. The child was unaware of the item and the classroom staff handled the matter by following protocol.</p>
