October 27, 2025

Attendance:

Ms. Schlissel- Principal, Ms. Dumervil- Assistant Principal, Mrs. Vargas-5th SAC Chair, Ms. Demps- ESP staff (noninstructional employee), Ms. Jennifer Brown-IMT, Kaitlin Hogdton- Community/Business Representative, Nancy Ladouceur- I-Zone Representative, Ms. Juanita Langford- (ESE Parent), Ms. Williams- 1st grade teacher, Mrs. Hernandez- 4th grade teacher, and Ms. Etienne- 4th grade teacher. There was a quorum.

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Miramar Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the school's media center on October 27, 2025. Mrs. Vargas motioned to open the meeting at 2:23PM and recorded minutes for this meeting.

Agenda Items:

- Introductions of staff members (Ms. Schlissel, Ms. Dumervil, Mrs. Vargas, Ms. Demps, Ms. Brown, Ms. Hodgton, Ms. Ladoucer, Ms. Williams, Mrs. Hernandez, Mrs. Etienne,) and Parents (Ms. Langford)
- Mrs. Vargas welcomed everyone to our SAC meeting. Ms. Schlissel shared upcoming events to be held at Miramar Elementary. Vocabulary Parade will be on Friday, October 31, 2025. November 11, there is no school in observance of Veteran's Day. There is a great possibility that Miramar Elementary will not be involved in the Repurposing of Schools. No input was provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Ms. Schlissel shared that we have not received A+ funds yet however they are expected to be available end of October/beginning of November. She also shared that SAC Accountability Funds are not available as of today however they are also expected to be available at the end of October. The goal is to vote on the A+ ballot as well as how to utilize all the funds in the SAC Accountability account in the same SAC meeting. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Mrs. Dumervil shared the School Improvement Plan Monitoring and Stakeholder's Feedback. We discussed our school's School Improvement

plan and Title I Addendum. We discussed our SIP goals in Reading to move from 65% to 68% in ELA Proficiency and how we have used personnel differently to achieve our goal. We shared with parents Title I addendum and their location in the front office. The participants agreed with the growth and the shifts made thus far. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.

- Mrs. Dumervil shared there were 5 discipline referrals. She stated our students enjoy shopping at the Manatee Store. Teachers shared they needed more manatee bucks to give to students. Ms. Etienne shared how 4th grade celebrated Green Light behavior last week. Students who always display proper behavior were celebrated with ice cream. Ms. Williams shared how she allows her first graders to take ownership of their day by sharing how what type of day they had and how many class dojo points they should earn. Input provided by teacher, parent, community.
- Ms. Schlissel shared how teachers have check in with their students daily in form of community meetings to see how students are doing emotionally and to provide a safe opportunity for students to share how their day is going. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Mrs. Dumervil shared the importance of the Parent Family Engagement Plan. She shared the Reading Under the Stars event that was held last year incorporating science and reading skills. We had a huge turn out. Ms. Ladoucer shared that students can maybe be involved in an academic competition. Ms. Williams shared how we can host a science fair night by grade level. She also shared her attendance to the STEMfest event held by Title I on October 25, 2025 and gave positive reviews about it. She suggested Miramar Elementary to hold a similar event at our school. Mrs. Dumervil shared our Honor Roll celebration will be on 11/7/25. Mrs. Hernandez mentioned that Wendy's is willing to provide free breakfast to those students however they will not provide delivery. She also mentioned if students can earn any incentives for Reading Across Broward. Ms. Williams suggested if one Honor Roll assembly possibly for 3rd or 4th quarter can involve parent participation.
