Miramar Elementary School Advisory Council/School Advisor Forum Minutes January 27, 2025

Attendance:

Ms. Schlissel- Principal, Ms. Dumervil- Assistant Principal, Mrs. Vargas-5th Grade/SAC Chair, Ms. Demps- ESP staff (noninstructional employee), Ms. Jennifer Brown-Community/Business Representative, Ms. Juanita Langford- (ESE Parent), Ms. Lynn Hernandez (ESOL Parent), Ms. Nancy Ladoucer (Pre-K parent). There was a quorum.

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Miramar Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the school's media center on October 28, 2024. Mr. Vargas motioned to open the meeting and recorded minutes for this meeting.

Agenda Items:

- Introductions of staff members (Ms. Schlissel, Ms. Dumervil, Mrs. Vargas, Ms. Demps) and Parents (Ms. Langford, Ms. Ladouceur, Ms. Hernandez).
- Ms. Schlissel and Mrs. Dumervil welcomed everyone to our meeting. Mrs. Dumervil congratulated our teacher's hard work in showing growth between Progress Monitoring 1 and Progress Monitoring 2 including our MOY science data. Miramar Elementary school is moving in the right direction. Miramar Elementary School was showcased in the District showcase and we shared all the programs we offer; ESE HeadStart etc. Mrs. Dumervil shared our Kindergarten Splash will be in two sessions: one on January 30 and February 19. On February 19, we will be having our Black History Comes to Life event in the evening. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Mrs. Vargas shared the importance of parents becoming SAC members. It is a great way for parents to be aware of what is happening at their child's school. Additionally, we can not vote on how to utilize SAC Accountability Funds that will benefit our students if there is no quorum. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Mrs. Vargas shared the amount of the school accountability funds has not been released yet. We are still pending on some reimbursements to occur.

- Once reimbursements reflect our SAC funds, we will have the SAC accountability fund amount. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Ms. Johnson shared Miramar Elementary's LSW plan. Broward county offers two resources; ReThinkEd and Inner Explore. ReThinkEd has lessons for students to complete following the districts guide. The lessons focus on how to work through different emotions. The other resource gives students tips on how to meditate and work through their emotions. Ms. Johnson shared she is available if a teacher needs her to teach a LSW lesson during our LSW block which is 10 minutes everyday. She is also available to meet with a student, individually, if they are showing any signs of behavior/emotional concern. Mrs. Dumervil added the importance of teaching these skills to our students. Ms. Laudeceur asked if we had a social worker on campus. Mrs. Dumervil shared that we share a social worker with another school and she works from our school two days a week; Tuesday and Thursday. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Mrs. Vargas shared the Annual Evaluation survey data. As of today, we have 29 parents/families who have completed the survey. The majority of our responses were agree and strongly agree. We will continue to push for surveys to be completed via ClassDojo, Parent Link. No input was provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Mrs. Dumervil shared our Parent Family Engagement plan for the 24-25 school year. Our plan focuses on creating events/meetings to keep our families informed and provide resources for our Miramar Elementary school families. Mrs. Vargas shared that we will make any edits/corrections, if needed to the Parent Family Engagement Plan for the upcoming 25-26 school year. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
