Meeting Minutes March 23, 2026 at 2:20 PM in the Media Center

Attendance:

Mrs. Vargas- SAC Chair; Ms. Schlissel- Principal, Ms. Dumervil- Assistant Principal, Ms. Demps-ESP staff (noninstructional employee), Ms. Jennifer Brown-IMT, and Mr. Pintavalle- BTU Steward. Ms. Langford, Parent; Mrs. Ladouceur Parent and Ms. Williams, Parent. We had a quorum.

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Miramar Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the school's media center on March 23, 2026. Ms. Schlissel motioned to open the meeting at 2:20PM and recorded minutes for this meeting.

Agenda Items:

- Introductions of staff members (Mrs. Vargas, Ms. Schlissel, Ms. Dumervil, Ms. Demps, Ms. Brown, Mr. Pintavalle,) Welcome Parents Mrs. Ladouceur, Ms. Williams, and Mrs. Langford.
- Ms. Schlissel welcomed everyone to our SAC meeting of . Ms. Schlissel shared that we will be having a Pre-Mother's Day Tea Party on April 23, 2026 at 5:00 PM in the Media Center for Kindergarten students and a special adult in their lives. No input was provided by teachers, parents, and the community.
- Ms. Schlissel shared with the SAC Committee the funds available for Parental Involvement from Title 1 for the 26-27 school year. We are allotted \$3, 243.00. We usually spend the money on refreshments for parents during our family night events and we purchase student planners for all students this is our means of communication with parents. It also is the place where all students write their homework and get it signed daily by the parents and the teacher. Any essential information goes through the students' planners. SAC Committee including parents were given the opportunity to give input and to contribute to the conversation but decided

to use the money in the same way for the upcoming school year. After that no other input was provided by teachers, parents, and the community.

- Mrs. Dumervil shared our school's School Improvement Plan and Monitoring & Stakeholder's Feedback: She shared SIP goals in Reading to improve our scores. Last year our students scored 65%. Our goal this year is to get 68%. We have worked with the Elementary Reading Department to help us sustain and maintain our reading proficiency. We are currently meeting with our Intermediate teachers, and we are monitoring their classes' growth and progress. We are preparing for PM 3 Spring Assessment Dates will be announced soon. In Science, we have just taken the MOY in Science Part 2 and our 5th grade students are making great academic gains in science. Stakeholders agreed with this data discussed. No input is provided by teachers, parents, and the community.
Stakeholders participated in the development of the upcoming School Improvement Plan and Title I Addendum. The decision of the stakeholders is to continue to make gains in reading, math & science. After that no input was provided by teachers, parents, & community.
- Miramar's Parent & Family Engagement Plan PFEP for 2026-2027. Mrs. Dumervil presented the proposed PFEP 2026-2027 to the stakeholders. All stakeholders were given an opportunity to review the old plan and give input and ideas into the upcoming year's plan. Ms. Demps said that she would like more family nights next year. So, we took it into consideration as we proposed events for the upcoming school year. The stakeholders were satisfied and said to continue with the plan as proposed. No other input was provided by parents, teachers, community, and staff.
- Mrs. Dumervil also discussed the Miramar Elementary School-Parent-Compact and as a team we discussed what to keep and what to edit. Parents were given an opportunity to review the current plan and provide input on the upcoming plan. All stakeholders were satisfied with the former plan and agreed to leave the compact as is for the 2026-2027 school year.
- Mrs. Dumervil shared the results from the Annual Evaluation from 2025-2026. We were happy to see that our students, staff, and parent responses

were similar. Most saying they feel safe and supported at Miramar Elementary. The overall score was 89% strongly agreed that Miramar Elementary School is a safe and supportive environment for learning.

- Ms. Schlissel shared there are no new Discipline/SESIR incidents to report.
- SAC Accountability Funds remain the same.




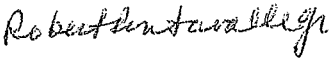

Ms. Schlissel motioned to adjourn the meeting, and Mr. Pintavalle seconded the motion at 2:55 PM.

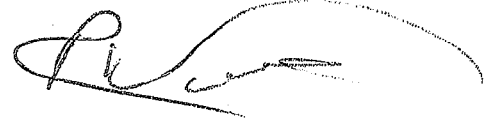
