August 25, 2025

Attendance:

Ms. Schlissel- Principal, Ms. Dumervil- Assistant Principal, Mrs. Vargas-5th grade math & science teacher, Ms. Etienne- 4th grade math & science teacher, Ms. Demps- ESP staff (noninstructional employee), Mr. Pintavalle-BTU Representative, Ms. Jennifer Rodriguez- 5th grade ESOL parent, Mr. Victor Rodriguez- 5th grade ESOL parent. There was a quorum.

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Miramar Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the school's media center on August 25, 2025. Mrs. Vargas motioned to open the meeting. Mr. Pintavalle seconded the motion. Mrs. Vargas recorded minutes for this meeting.

Agenda Items:

- Introductions of staff members (Ms. Schlissel, Ms. Dumervil, Mrs. Vargas, Ms. Demps, Mr. Pintavalle, Ms. Etienne) and Parents (Mr. Victor Rodriguez and Ms. Jennifer Rodriguez)
- Ms. Schlissel announced we are an A school and the highest A in Miramar. Open House will be 9/10/2025 in the evening. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Mrs. Vargas reviewed what SAC and SAF is. SAC focuses on the curriculum/academic of the school and the SAF focuses on any not academic related (operational). SAC holds 8 meetings within the school year (monthly). We need more parents than teachers to be members of SAC. Mrs. Dumervil added the importance of having a quorum in order to vote on utilization of school accountability funds. Mrs. Vargas shared the amount of the school accountability funds has not been released yet. She shared will be receiving A+ money possibly after FTE, sometime in October. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Parent Involvement- Ms. Vargas shared the importance of parental involvement. She encouraged parents to share with other parents from

Miramar Elementary to join SAC. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.

- Ms. Dumervil shared the components of the School Improvement Plan. SIP includes; Early Warning Indicators, Title I Addendum, K-12 Reading Plan, Professional Learning Community, MTSS, Life Skill Wellness, School Wide Behavior Plan, School Counseling Plan, Equity Plan, Best Practice, and Family Community Plan. Mrs. Vargas added that at each SAC meeting, one of the components of the School Improvement Plan will be shared. Mrs. Vargas added the areas of improvement at Miramar Elementary. Reading proficiency, learning gains and lowest quartile are areas of improvement listed in our SIP. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Mrs. Vargas shared there are no discipline/SESIR reports to share. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
- Title I is federal money given to schools to purchase agendas, certain parent nights, pays our coaches and intervention positions, and resources to help instruction in the classroom. This money is based on a percentage of students receiving free/reduce lunch. No input provided by teacher, parent and community.





