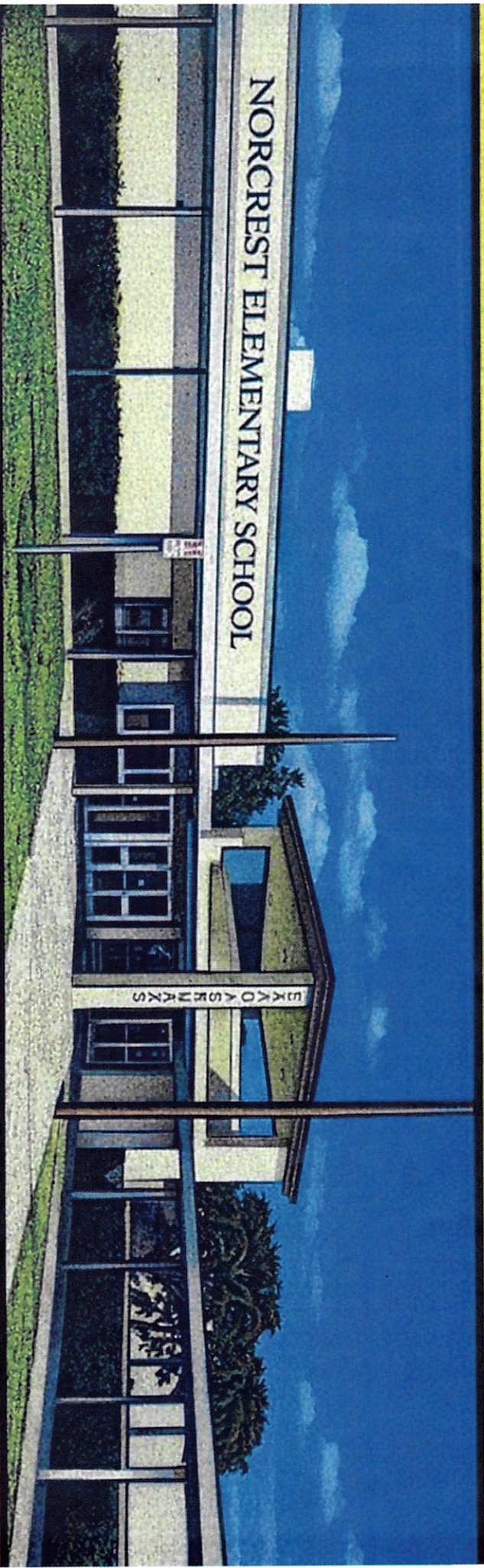

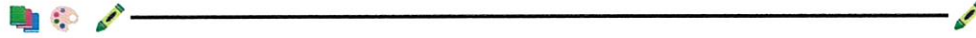

Minutes from SAC meeting March 26, 2026

Attendance: 6 out of 7 members

Secretary Phyllis Wimbley called the meeting to order at 6 PM. Brandi Zabadal gave the second motion. Chantel Gutierrez recorded the minutes for the meeting.

The members and guests were welcomed to the meeting.

The minutes from the last meeting were reviewed. Brandi Zabadal motioned to approve the minutes. Chantel Gutierrez gave the second motion. The members approved the minutes.

The position of SAC chair was discussed. Brandi Zabadal was unanimously elected as SAC chair.

The SAC accountability fund was discussed. The fund has \$4762. It was proposed to spend \$500 for science camp, \$200 for the 5th grade student carnival, and the remaining \$4062 for magnetic instructional workbooks. Based on the decrease in school performance in science as an area of focus in the SIP plan, Mr. Castillo discussed the addition of science camps for 5th grade. Based on the information given, attendees had no additional input for this item. Attendees asked questions regarding how students would benefit from the magnetic workbooks. Teachers gave input regarding their support for the magnetic workbooks and how they are used in the classroom. Parents had no further input on this item. Chantel Gutierrez moved to spend the remaining accountability funds as proposed. Brandi Zabadal seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The 25/26 Parent Family Engagement Plan (PFEP) was presented by Principal Castillo and reviewed by the attendees. The PFEP survey results were also presented and reviewed. The survey indicated that families were getting the most information regarding their student's success from their teachers. The attendees agreed that the results were overall positive. No additional parent input was provided. The 26/27 Parent and Family Engagement Plan was discussed. Attendees were given an opportunity to review the current plan and provide input on the upcoming plan. The following input was provided to develop the plan including adding Publix Math Night, Science Night, ESOL Game Night, Parent University, Robotics Club, Jellyfish Museum, and I-ready meetings. Attendees discussed using parent allocation funds for 26-27 to provide childcare, refreshments, or dinners to increase attendance at meetings and events. No parental input provided for the 25-26 parental allocation fund.

The school-parent compact from 2025-2026 was presented and reviewed by attendees. The proposed school-parent compact for 2026-2027 was reviewed and discussed. Attendees were given the opportunity to review the current plan and provide input on the

upcoming plan. Input included adding information about not using cellphones during school hours, also not using smartwatches for communication during school hours. The 2026-2027 compact will be amended to include those items.

Principal Castillo gave his report. He thanked PTA and staff. He discussed testing dates and communications will be going home. He discussed year end activities for PK-5th grade. Class photos are complete. The yearbook is in progress. He discussed the i-Ready challenge for K-5 and the winning class gets a pizza party.

During the open discussion committee members discussed the noise level from the north side of the school has increased since 2025. It is occurring from 5:30am to nearly midnight. It is making it difficult for them to enjoy their backyards. It is especially bothersome at night. Mr. Castillo will be addressing the issue with facilities and district maintenance to try to resolve the issue.

In alignment with our school improvement plan, parents, teachers, and community members were given the opportunity to discuss and contribute during the SAC meeting for the plans for our upcoming school year.

The next meeting is scheduled for April 16, 2026.

The motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Becky Pirtle. Chantel Gutierrez seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 7pm.
