1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at **5:08 PM** by **Ms. Marqueta Ellis**. A quorum was present.

2. Approval of Previous Minutes

The minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed.

3. Principal's Message and Mid-Year Data Review

Ms. Denise Lawrence, Principal, welcomed members to the January meeting, acknowledged new attendees, and wished everyone a Happy New Year. She explained that the purpose of the presentation was to share **mid-year academic data** and discuss school progress. **Ms. Imbert** provided translation support.

Assessment Overview

- Students are assessed **three times per year**: fall, winter (before winter break), and spring (April–May).
- Data comparisons included:
 - End of last year
 - This time last year
 - Beginning of this year
 - Current mid-year data

Reading Data

- The schoolwide reading proficiency goal is **40% or higher**.

Retention

- Last year's retention numbers:
 - 1st Grade: 2 students
 - 2nd Grade: 15 students
 - 3rd Grade: 20 students
- The school aims to reduce retention by addressing attendance issues and ensuring students receive needed interventions.

Student Demographics and Support Programs

- Total enrollment: **587 students**
- English Language Learners (ELL): **408 students**
- Students with Disabilities (ESE): **90 students**
- Gifted students included within ESE count
- H.E.A.R.T. (homeless/displaced students): **12 students**
- Foster care students: **None identified**
- 504 plans: **2 pending approvals**

Student Support Services

- Social worker referrals: **~750 referrals** this year
- School counselor interventions:
 - Last year: 1,169
 - This year (to date): 287
- Resiliency Education Program: **96% student completion rate**



- A **Math Specials period** has been added alongside Music and PE.
