## **School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting Minutes**

**Date:** April 22, 2026

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### **1. Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at **5:19 PM** by **Marqueta Ellis**.

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### **2. Opening Activity**

- The **Pledge of Allegiance** was led by a fifth-grade student.
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### **3. Principal/Administrative Report**

**Presented by:** Raylene Thomas, Assistant Principal (serving as acting principal)

- Mrs. Thomas introduced herself as the acting principal in the absence of the principal.
- **Accountability Funds Update:**
  - SAC previously approved spending of staff accountability funds.
  - Remaining balance: **\$541.50**.
  - Funds will be used for **student incentives**, including testing motivation and behavior rewards.
  - Some funds were not spent due to vendor and deadline limitations.
- **SESIR Report:**
  - No school environmental safety incidents reported.
- **Testing Updates (FAST Assessments):**
  - Testing is underway for **Kindergarten through 5th grade**.
  - First grade testing has been completed (makeups ongoing).
  - Upcoming testing schedule:
    - Kindergarten: April 28–29

- 2nd Grade: April 30–May 1
  - 3rd Grade: May 6–7
  - 4th Grade: May 14–15
  - 5th Grade: May 8 & May 12
- **Student Motivation Initiatives:**
    - Planned **pep rally** for grades 3–5.
    - **Testing buddy program** pairing primary and intermediate students.
  - **5th Grade Updates:**
    - Upcoming **awards ceremony (moving up)** and **end-of-year dance**.
    - Information will be sent home soon.
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#### **4. School Improvement Presentation**

**Presented by:** Nicole Davis

- Overview of **FAST (Florida Assessment of Student Thinking)** assessments:
  - Administered three times per year (PM1, PM2, PM3).
  - PM3 (end-of-year) is used for **promotion decisions**.
- **Promotion Criteria:**
  - Students must earn **Level 2 or higher** in **ELA and Math**.
  - A **Level 3 or higher** is recommended for strong readiness.
- **Assessment Details by Grade:**
  - K–1: Early literacy and math (timed questions).
  - 2nd Grade: Reading comprehension and math.
  - 3rd–5th: ELA and Math; 5th also takes Science.
- **Testing Conditions:**
  - Computer-based testing for all students.
  - Extended time provided as needed (IEP/ELL accommodations).

- Testing sessions may last up to a full school day for upper grades.
  - **Instructional Supports:**
    - 90-minute reading block (120 minutes for targeted students).
    - Small group instruction and interventions.
    - Push-in/pull-out support services.
    - After-school tutoring programs for targeted students.
  - **Parent Resources:**
    - FAST portal and family portal for monitoring student progress.
    - Practice tools and translated materials available online.
  - **3rd Grade Promotion Policy:**
    - Mandatory retention if Level 2 is not achieved in ELA.
    - Options include **summer school** and reassessment opportunities.
  - **Parent Testing Tips:**
    - Ensure adequate sleep and a healthy breakfast.
    - Maintain positive communication.
    - Practice reading and math skills at home.
    - Address test anxiety with calming strategies.

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
