School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting Minutes

Date: January 12, 2026

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 8:42 AM by A. Sears.

Old Business

- Staff reviewed the minutes from the December 17, 2025, SAC meeting.
- R. Davis made motion to approve minutes; Chin Sue seconded and motion carried.
- Staff congratulated Mrs. Reid on her appointment to the 4th grade teaching position.
- A. Sears reported an error with the A+ Funds ballot voting and the removal of Baldwin from prior meeting minutes. Although quorum was met, the district requires the voting process to be redone. Two SAC/SAF meetings (January 12 and January 16, 2026) will be used to address the ballot discussion. A staff revote for A+ Funds is scheduled for April 22, 2026. The A+ Funds submission deadline is February 1, 2026.
- 100th Day of School Math Activity:
 - Proposal was approved by SAC; however, the district denied reimbursement due to supplies purchased from a non-authorized vendor (Amazon).
 - Dr. Brown and R. Davis reported covering the \$250 cost personally.
- Xtreme Action Park Field Trip
 - R. Davis inquired about approval status.
 - Dr. Brown must submit a written summary detailing how the end-of-year trip aligns with student needs. The district will then forward the proposal for review.
- Technology Needs Survey (IT Fulwood)
 - 22 staff responses were received.
 - Bluetooth/USB speakers were selected.
 - District continues to provide laptops; delivery timeline is pending.
 - Staff were asked not to remove technology from classrooms during inventory.

 - BTA meeting is scheduled for this week (January 14).

 - **3rd:** 75% met 2% criteria
 - **4th:** 50% met 2% criteria
 - **5th:** 100% met 2% criteria
 - **6th/ RISE:** 88% met 2% criteria
 - Students demonstrating growth in both areas will receive Panda Express incentive provided by (J. Espejo, school SW).
