Call to Order

Approval of Minutes: February minutes from SAC/SAF meeting were read. Ms. R. Davis made a motion to approve minutes with corrections. It was seconded by Ms. Flint. Motion carried and February Minutes were approved.

Reports

Principal's Report

- Recap of Visit from Orange County School District- Extremely impressed!
- Speak Up & Speak Out BCPS Student Advisory representative wrote a letter about PRC stating that our visit was the most inspirational and productive visit had out of 43 visits. (Kudos to the faculty and staff)

ESE- Per A. Sears (ESE Support)- Based on previous meeting with ESE Specialist, a lot of students entering the school are ESE.

Science- Mid Year Assessment 2 (needs information from Science Department). Tentative 5th Grade Science testing dates per Testing Coordinator: Thurs, March 26th and Fri, March 27th.

School Counselor- Per Ms. Mogul- Plantation Palms field trips are on hold.

Testing Coordinator – Per A. Sears-

- Writing Test is 3/31- There will be a testing review meeting Friday before the Writing Test.
- K-2 STAR Assessment is 4/21- 4/22
- Life Skills & Wellness- No update (Mcintyre not present)
