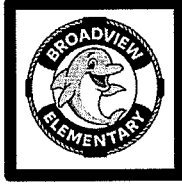

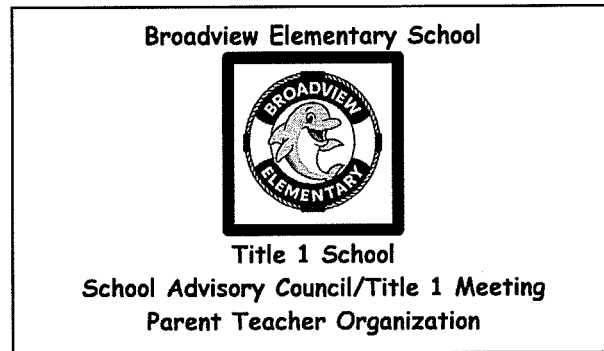

School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes – Thursday, January 29, 2026

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Broadview School Advisory Council was held **Thursday, January 29, 2026**, in the cafeteria. **Chair Ms. Diamond** called the meeting to order at **5:30 PM**. Introductions of those presenting were made. Quorum was not met, however, there were no items to be voted on except for the minutes of the December 17th meeting.

Minutes:

- Minutes from the SAC, **12-17-25** meeting presented to all guests.

- Seconded: Ms. Mosser seconded the motion.

New Business:

- 21ST Century: N. Alabre, Coordinator -
 - The purpose of the 21st Century afterschool program is to provide students with academic support, enrichment activities, and a safe place to learn after school. This program is funded through a government grant.
 - 21st Century is currently serving 78 students in grades 1–5. They are in the process of implementing Girl Scouts as a new initiative in partnership with Sunshine. The initial parent orientation for this partnership, which introduced families to the Girl Scout program, took place on Wednesday, January 21st.
 - Thursday, January 29th, the Girl Scouts will participate in their first-ever Girl Scout cookie sale.
 - Additionally, 21st Century is partnering with PTO to provide students with opportunities to strengthen their social skills & engage in community service through thematic, project-based learning experiences.
- Tonight, Broadview will host Literacy Night that aligns with the school's theme "We Stick Together at Broadview."
 - A cactus/desert theme with interactive grade-level activities aligned to the Florida's BEST standards.
 - Families will receive take-home literacy resources supporting literacy development at home.

- Kindergarten Round-up was held this morning to welcome all in-coming Kindergartners for the school year of 2026-2027

- Ms. Diamelys, Broadview's Social Worker, continues to implement strategies to improve student attendance, which is expected to positively impact academic performance.
