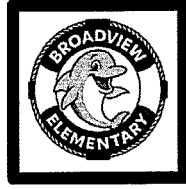

School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes – Wednesday, February 25, 2026

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Broadview School Advisory Council was held **Wednesday, February 25, 2026**, in the cafeteria. **Chair Ms. Diamond** called the meeting to order at **3:00 PM**. Introductions of those presenting were made. Quorum was met; request for use of accountability and other school funds will be voted on.

Minutes:

- Minutes from the SAC, **1-29-2026** meeting presented to all guests.
- Motion to approve **1-29-2026** SAC minutes by C. Diamond.
- Seconded: Ms. Smith seconded the motion.

New Business:

- Reading for the Record
- 21ST Century: N. Alabre, Coordinator
 - Continuation of selling of Girl Scout cookies
 - Clubs for community service such as the Environmental club, Dancing club and Arts and Crafts club.
- Math Night – Mathnasium will be presenting 12 different activities for parents and students for grades K-5. Volunteers are needed.

Reports:

- Principal's report –
- School beautification:
 - Broadview is painting several murals on different walls
 - Painting of the inside of the school is continuing
- Instructional Review took place February 3rd – outcome was to focus on reading and math discourse
- School Accountability Funds Report: \$ 3083.03 as of February 25, 2026. Voting on use of School Accountability Funds for Math Manipulatives for Grades K-5 in the amount of \$2803.
- School funds available: \$6009 as of February 25, 2026. Voting on use of school funds for the following:
 - \$1500 for Iready Magnetic curriculum
 - 304.64 for custodial coverage
 - \$3000 for school murals
 - Left over monies for: EOY trophies and pins, brag bags as an incentive for students, and teacher appreciation gifts

- C. Diamond moved to discuss the use of the School's Accountability funds and other school funds to supply K-5 teachers with Math Manipulatives, Iready Magnetic curriculum, custodial coverage and student and teacher incentives/gifts. J. Smith seconded the motion to allow for the discussion to take place.
 - Motion now opened for discussion by C. Diamond, SAC Chair. It was noted that the purpose of supplying teachers with their "wish list" of math manipulatives was to support and strengthen the math curriculum. The Iready magnetic curriculum will be used to supplement the reading curriculum for Teir 2/3 students. These extra resources also help teachers better support diverse learning needs and improve overall student achievement.
 - The remaining funds will be allocated toward both student and teacher incentives
 - After an explanation of why the SAC committee wants to purchase these math tools and other expenditures, the motion to allocate the School's Accountability funds and Other school monies were approved with **9 votes in favor** and **0 opposed**.
