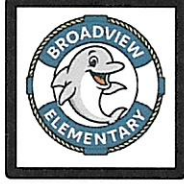

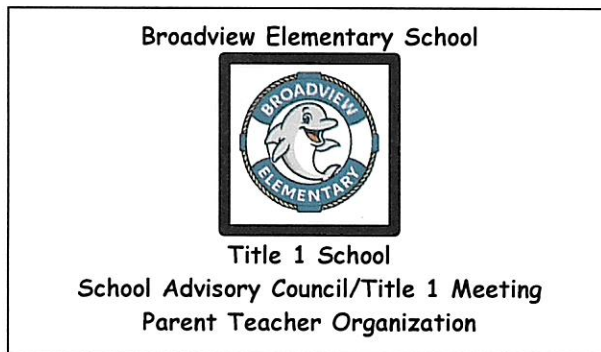

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Broadview School Advisory Council was held **Wednesday May 20, 2026**, in the Media Center. **Ms. Diamond** called the meeting to order at **2:30 PM**. Introductions of those presenting were made. Quorum was met; however, there were no items to be voted on except for the minutes of the April 29th meeting.

Minutes:

- Review of the 2026–2027 school-wide positive behavior plan: Student success outcomes for the 2026–2027 school year will be measured by a 50% reduction in incidents of disobedience and insubordination by the end of the year.

2025 - 2026 School Improvement Monitoring and Feedback

- 3rd grade reading scores rose 10 percentage points from last year
- 4th and 5th grade reading and math PM3 scores have a positive trend upward

Review of 2025-2026 SIP Progress:

- ➔ 3-5th grades show an upward trend in proficiency
- ➔ Attendance has improved due to Social Worker follow-ups
- ➔ Behavior incidents have shown a decline since the start of the School Store, earning students “money” for positive behavior

Proposed SIP Goals:

- ➔ Increase learning gains for students who score in the lowest quartile
- ➔ Further reduce chronic absenteeism
- ➔ Data-driven instruction for Tier 3 students

Attendants thanked committee members for supporting student success.


