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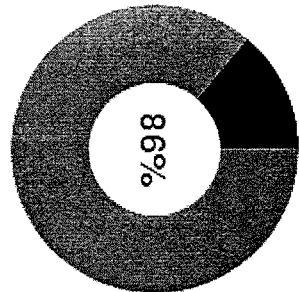

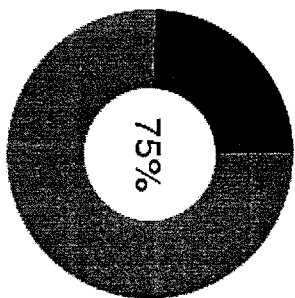

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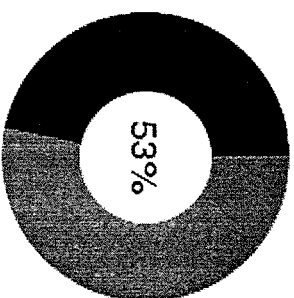

 - A+Funds Amount: \$41,028
 - The School Advisory Council (SAC) creates a ballot with written proposals aligned to the approved use of the school recognition awards in Florida Statute 1008.36.
 - The ballot must list all proposals for dispensing the A+ Funds, including, 'None of the above.'
 - The ballot must include a statement to specify the use of leftover funds.
 - SAC must vote by roll call to approve the proposals for the ballot. A quorum (50% plus 1 of the total required members) must be present for voting to take place. The process must be recorded in the minutes.
 - Use percentages, not dollar amounts
 - The staff ballots cast must match the number of staff signatures on the voting roster

All leftover funds will be used for nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment and materials.
