- Call to Order
 - Welcome
 - The meeting was called to order by Ms. McCartha at 2:20. Ms. Zinn motioned, and Ms. McWhorter seconded the motion.

 - Ms. McHugh motioned, Ms. Zinn seconded the motion
- SIP Monitoring
 - Review and Discuss: McNab Elementary 2025-2026 Annual Title I School Parent and Family Engagement Survey
 - 64 Responses; Title I requires 53%, so we are in compliance
 - Mostly favorable responses
 - Parents/Stakeholders were given an opportunity to review the current plan and provide input on the upcoming plan. The following input/suggestions were given. A discussion was held on strategies to increase survey responses from families, emphasizing the importance of reaching all households. Suggestions included sending paper surveys and providing them in parents' native languages to better support ELL families. Ms. McCartha agreed these were good ideas, and members offered to assist with entering the returned survey data.

- Plan and develop 2026-2027 Parent and Family Engagement Plan E5-Parents/Stakeholders were given an opportunity to review the upcoming Plan-Ms.McHugh recommended a curriculum seminar given by teachers during school hours to show parents how to help their child(ren) at home with skills students are currently learning in school. Response from parents and stakeholders was favorable.




