  - Welcome
  - The meeting was called to order by Ms. McCartha at 2:20. Ms. Zinn motioned, and Ms. Santiago seconded the motion.

  - Ms. Rohloff presented the Behavior Plan outline for the upcoming year:

  - Referrals:
    - The highest number of referrals was 49, and about half came from inside the classroom.
    - The goal is to decrease the number next year by 20%
  - Input was solicited from Parents/Stakeholders, but no input or suggestions were given.




