SAC Minutes: Draft

- Welcome
 - The meeting was called to order at 2:24. Ms. McHugh motioned, and Ms. Morgan seconded the motion.
 - New Secretary, Ms. Greger was announced, and introductions were made.
- Norms
- Minutes Approval-May
 - Ms. McHugh motioned, and Ms. Grant seconded the motion.
- Vote on 25-26 School Advisory Committee Bylaws
 - Bylaws were approved unanimously
- Accountability Funds: \$5,946.90
 - ClassWallet: Mrs. McCartha explained that funds not utilized by teachers can go back into the accountability funds.
 - Ms. Zinn asked if the funds were going to be used for tutoring (ELO Camp), and Mrs. McCartha stated that the usage will be voted on.

- Principal Update
 - Ms. Rohloff explained the new security measures: Parents/Visitors who are dropping off items or entering the school will be met by a staff member who will require proper ID.
 - Administration/Teachers are actively monitoring student absences and tardies. Ms. Rohloff stated that if necessary, the school social worker will be contacted in order to offer support for families.
- SESIR-School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting: Ms. Rohloff stated there were 2 small incidents.
- SIP Goals/School Improvement Plan
 - Mrs. McCarthy explained that the SIP Plan now includes classroom samples/school information displayed in the front office as part of our Family and Community Engagement Plan (FACE).
 - SAC Bylaws must be done by October 6, 2025, and will be given to the Board for approval by October 14, 2025.
 - Teachers/Staff will be receiving funds for McNab being an “A School.” More information to come.
- Title One Updates
 - Ms. McCarthy stated that we are now 30% complete with compliance
 - We need families to sign up for free lunch so that we can keep our Title 1 status/resources.
 - Ms. McHugh asked if teachers should encourage families to sign up, and Mrs. McCarthy said yes.







- Equity
 - Ms. Garcia said that McNab was celebrating Hispanic Heritage Month, International Peace Week, and Cancer Awareness Month.
 - October will also celebrate Red Ribbon Week; more information to follow.
- Open Agenda
 - Mrs. McCartha and Ms. Garcia are looking into advancing technology education. This includes Minecraft Education which will infuse the students' curriculum during media.
 - The media center will be renamed "Innovative Learning Commons."
 - The Crockett Foundation comes 1x per month (every 2nd Friday) for 5th grade.
 - Ms. Bolender started the Eco Club. She also wrote an agricultural grant, so will start growing fruits and vegetables. A butterfly garden will also be started.
 - Ms. Frankey started the Music Club.
 - 5th grade went to BizTown
 - FTE Week is next week.
 - Q1 ends on October 10, and report cards are October 21.
 - Testing: Completed PM1, iReady Diagnostics, Math and Science
 - Data was shown showing a comparison of PM3 2024, and PM3 2025 along with goals for PM3 2026.


- Meeting was adjourned at 2:50. Ms. McHugh motioned and Greger seconded the motion.


