- Call to Order
 - Welcome
 - The meeting was called to order by Ms. McCartha at 2:24. Ms. Morgan motioned, and Ms. Zinn seconded the motion.
- Introductions
 - Attendees introduced themselves and their positions
- Voting was held to vote for Kelley Santiago as our Gifted Representative
 - Ms. Santiago was approved unanimously
- SAC Training Part 1
 - Ms. McCartha explained the purpose and components of the School Advisory Council
 - SAC is comprised of parents, teachers, administration, and community members
 - 53% non-school
 - 47% staff

 - Ms. McCartha explained that there must meet quorum present in order to vote, so please let her know if you are unavailable to attend the meeting.








- Approval of Minutes
 - Ms. McHugh motioned, and Ms. Zinn seconded the motion.
- SIP Monitoring
 - Review of the SIP Plan with the Title One Addendum
 - Ms. McCartha explained that some components of the School Improvement Plan include: Title 1, MTSS/RtI, CPST, Schoolwide Behavior Plan, attendance, PLCs, and SAC. No input provided by teachers, parents, and community.
 - Ms. McCartha explained that it is very important for McNab to keep its Title One Program. These funds provide resources and even staffing to our school
 - Right now we have 61.69% of families eligible, but we need 65% by February
 - It is very important to offer support to families so that they receive information needed to apply
 - This year McNab has academic focus on small group instruction and lesson plans encompassing rigor in creating challenging learning experiences that incorporate critical thinking.
- A+ Recognition Funds Process
 - Ms. McCartha explained that these funds are an incentive program/reward for productivity. McNab has gone from a “B” to an “A” school. It is not known what funding will be available to McNab. This is considered a nonrecurring bonus.
- Accountability Funds-\$4784.88
Voting was held for utilization of the accountability funds for the TOP Score Writing Program

- Mrs. Greger explained the TOP Score writing program and how it assists and supports Florida schools. This will be for grades 2-5. The cost is \$4050.
