

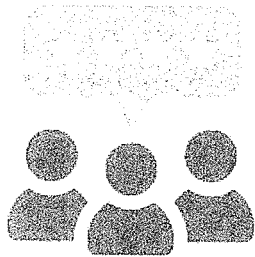

***I pasted proposal examples at the bottom of this email for quick reference, but please carefully read the materials Ms. Winston-Davis sent staff yesterday regarding A+ proposals, ballots, and voting.**

ALL proposals will be read and considered, and SAC committee members will discuss and vote on what proposals will make the ballot at the 12/11 SAC meeting.

***Please note that we must have a quorum to determine the ballot. If we do not have more than half our SAC members present the ballot will be discussed and determined at the January SAC meeting.**

Final ballot will be emailed to staff Friday, December 12.

ALL teachers and staff will cast their vote for A+ fund distribution on Wednesday, December 17.

Proposal examples:

Sample Proposal 1:

- 25% of the funds go to the school for nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment and materials: 3 Laptop carts, ELO Camp ELA supplemental materials for grades 3 and 4, and math supplemental materials for grade 5.
- 75% of the funds are for a one-time bonus to be divided among all 2024-2025 staff members. Staff must have worked at least 99 days of the 2024-2025 school year (per the 186-day calendar) to receive the bonus.
- All leftover funds will be used for nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment and materials.

Sample Proposal 2:

- 100% of the funds are for a one-time bonus to be divided among all 2024-2025 staff members.
