students are accessing and mastering standards-aligned skills.



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We have developed a structured “crunch time” plan that incorporates supplemental remediation/enrichment instruction with embedded state test prep.

Designing an Extended Learning Opportunities program specifically catering to our current learner needs to provide instruction and study outside the classroom but that complements classroom instruction.

Continuing our use of assessment data to drive instruction and address learning misconceptions as we prepare for the state science assessments in May.

- Language Arts: Smith-Courtney- The ELA department continues to work diligently to prepare students for the upcoming FAST PM3 ELA assessment. Current performance data from online standards-based selection tests indicate that 6th grade students are performing at 65% proficiency, 7th grade students at 75% proficiency, and 8th grade students at 73% proficiency.  
Teachers are implementing stamina practice sessions in which students complete cold-read assessments designed to closely mirror the FAST test format and administration. Following these sessions, teachers analyze student data to identify strengths and areas of need, using the results to provide targeted remediation and enrichment to support continued student growth.

- Math: Stewart- Starting ELO Math in the 18<sup>th</sup> and Flash Back Friday has started review of struggling Benchmarks
- Magnet: Britton- School score School of Excellence
- ESOL: Anderson - We have started WIDA ACCESS for ELLS Testing- this an yearly test to measure English acquisition in listening, reading, writing and speaking.
