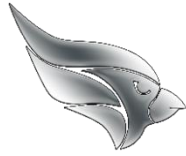

  - Science: Rivas- The Science BSA testing was administered in GEARS 2, Physical Science, and Biology on Wednesday, March 4. The assessment is comprehensive and measures student readiness for the Biology End-of-Course exam and the Statewide Science Assessment (SSA) scheduled for May. It also provides actionable data to inform instruction and targeted test preparation leading up to those assessments.
  - Language Arts: Smith-Courtney-The ELA Department has completed the Quarter 3 Scope and Sequence and is currently preparing students for the upcoming **BEST Writing Assessment**. Sixth and seventh graders will test on **March 31**, followed by eighth grade on **April 1**, with instruction focused on **Argumentative and Informative Writing**.  
Beginning **April 7 through May 1**, the department will implement **ELA Crunch Time**, where students will review and strengthen previously taught skills through a **student-centered station rotation model**.
