School Advisory Council (SAC)

General Meeting in the New River Middle School Exploratorium on Wednesday, February 5th, 2025 -4:30 PM I. Call to Order:

A meeting of the New River Middle School Advisory Council was held in the media center. SAC Chair Ronald Jules called the meeting to order at 4:34PM. 19 members were in attendance. Ms. Coombs recorded minutes for this meeting.

- **II. Review of Minutes:** Mr. Jules reviews last month's meeting minutes with the audience. Mrs. Frazier made a motion to accept the January meeting minutes. Mrs. Romansan seconded the motion.
- **III. Principal's Report**: Mrs. Harris starts by sharing highlights from the BCPS Showcase. Stranahan High School had a showcase here at NRMS to share their new magnet programs available there. Mrs. Harris also shares the Level Up Pep Rally Celebration, which was a huge success to reward the students for leveling up on their FAST PM2. Mrs, Harris then shares that Mrs. Berrios students went to the STEM engineering bridge competition. We also had our Zone Technology Night to align our community events. Mrs. Harris also shared that Ms. Coombs was honored last night at the City of Fort Lauderdale's Commissioners meeting for being teacher of the year. Mrs. Harris closes with our upcoming event, Mission Possible which is on Saturday February 8th 2025 from 12pm to 3pm. She also shares that honor roll will be next week 6th grade 2/11/25, 7th grade 2/12/25, and 8th grade 2/13/25.
- **IV. School Improvement Plan-Science**: Ms. Youngblood shares the upcoming assessment dates in science. She then goes on to share the action plan for science after students take the BSA. She describes that the action plan is broken down by month, sharing that each month will target a different area of need in science. She also shares that importance of family help, and having parents support their child at home, by having them work on their science packets at home.
