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### School Advisory Council (SAC)

General Meeting in the New River Middle School Exploratorium on Wednesday, May 7, 2025 -4:30 PM

#### I. Call to Order:

A meeting of the New River Middle School Advisory Council was held in the media center. SAC Chair Ronald Jules called the meeting to order at **4:42PM**. 14 members were in attendance. Ms. Coombs recorded minutes for this meeting.

**II. Review of Minutes:** Mr. Jules reviews last month's meeting minutes with the audience. Mrs. Frazier-Wright made a motion to accept the November meeting minutes. Mrs. Romansan seconded the motion.

**III. Principal's Report:** Mrs. Harris starts by sharing the projection of the upcoming budget for next school year. Mrs. Harris then shares some highlights from the last month, including The Ecology Club at City of Fort Lauderdale for our Eco-Sharks Club. We also had the Cortado Foundation Mural painted in our hallways, demonstrating our school's level, which is 5 feet above sea level.
