- **VII. Title 1 Update I. Title 1 Update**: Ms. Coombs shares copies of the current year's School Improvement Plan with Title I Plan Addendum to review with everyone. Ms. Coombs asks for input on the School Improvement Plan with Title I Plan Addendum and No input provided by teacher, parent and community.
- VIII.SAF/I -Zone: Dr.Jaks shares at the October meeting, principals shared what was going at each school including clubs, sports, etc. Stakeholders expressed concerns for the amendment in yesterday's poll, to have the SBBC election have oversight from the State government.
