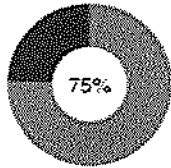

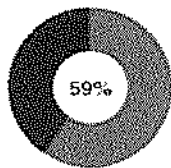

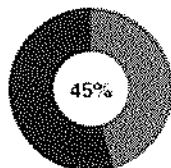

I. Call to Order

- The meeting was called to order at **2:20 PM**.

II. New Business

Principal provided an overview of the A+ School Recognition Program, explaining:

- Funds are awarded to schools that demonstrate significant improvement or maintain high academic performance (e.g., improving school grades or maintaining an "A" rating).

School Recognition Funds are non-recurring and may be used for:

- Faculty and staff bonuses
- Educational equipment or materials
- Temporary personnel to improve or maintain student performance
- SAC members develop and vote on proposals; however, staff votes on the proposals.
- If no proposal is approved by February 1, funds will be equally distributed among eligible staff by default.

The total amount awarded to the school was \$31,789 (net, after taxes).

- Funds must be allocated at 100%, with no remaining balance.
- Any unused funds must be applied to educational equipment or materials.

The Council discussed allowable expenditures and clarified that:

- Funds are **non-recurring**
- Any unused funds default to **educational equipment and materials**
- Student-related expenditures must be instructional or performance-based.

a. A+ Recognition Funds

i. Proposals and ballot creation

The Chair opened the floor for discussion regarding the proposed allocation of the **A+ School Recognition Funds**.

Discussion included:

- Clarification of how the funds may be used, emphasizing that A+ Funds are **non-recurring** and must support **faculty and staff recognition** and/or **educational purposes that contribute to student performance**. It was noted that any student-related expenditure must demonstrate a clear connection to academic improvement.
- Members discussed the reduction in total funds awarded this year compared to previous years and acknowledged

Feedback was shared regarding the importance of allocating a portion of the funds toward student incentives and schoolwide support, given the absence of a PTA and limited fundraising opportunities. It was also emphasized that students' academic success contributed directly to the school earning the A+ designation.

- The committee discussed the use of A+ School Recognition Funds to support student incentives, including **(tactile fidget devices, constructive manipulatives, social-emotional support tools, moldable tactile, collaborative strategy-based learning tools, kinesthetic sensory tools, motion-based learning tools, critical-thinking manipulatives, imaginative play resources, wearable motivational tokens, visual reinforcement tools, constructive engineering manipulatives, manipulative sensory materials, portable sensory compression tools, gross motor development materials, outdoor engagement tools, recreational movement resources, multi-sensory athletic manipulatives, movement-based regulation tools, writing instruments, community engagement reward, personalized reflection journals, personalized storage and mobility tools and visual learning tools).**

- Questions were raised regarding eligibility criteria, specifically the **100-day employment requirement**, and how staff who worked fewer than 100 days would be addressed in the proposals. Clarifications were provided for both Proposal 1 and Proposal 2, including how remaining funds would be applied to educational equipment or materials.
- This amount represents a significant decrease from the prior year's award.
- Due to reduced funding, student allocation was adjusted from 10% (previous year) to 5%

Written proposals:

Proposal 1

- 5% (\$1,589) of funds will be used for non-recurring expenditures on educational equipment or materials, extended learning opportunities to assist in maintaining and improving student performance.
- 95% (\$30,199) of funds will be used for a one-time bonus distributed the following way:
 - All SPE faculty and staff who worked at least 100 days at SPE during the 2024-2025 school year will receive an equal share. (Approx. \$450). Must have worked a minimum of 100 days to be eligible.

 - All faculty and staff who worked a minimum of 100 days at Sanders Park during the 2024- 2025 school year will receive an equal share. (approx. \$432)
- Any leftover A+ Funds will be used for non-recurring expenditures on educational equipment and materials
