GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

I. Call to Order

- Meeting was called to order at 5:50 PM by School Advisory Council (SAC) Chair Ms. Dessources.

II. Introduction

- Welcome from Principal, Ms. Dailey, newly appointed principal at Sanders Park Elementary.
- Introduction of SAC Chair Ms. Dessources, Public Speaking teacher and new member of Sanders Park Elementary.
- Introductions of new staff members.

III. Attendance

- Members and attendees were reminded to sign in for the official record.
Quorum was met 14/19.

IV. Approval of Previous Minutes

- Previous minutes were read by SAC Chair, Ms. Dessources. SAC Chair presents a motion to vote on the May-June minutes. Ms. Davis said, "I move to approve the May-June minutes." Ms. Walker-Brown said, "I second the motion to approve the May-June minutes. The motion of approving May-June minutes is going to the floor to vote. All in favor say "yea". The committee has unanimously approved the motion of the approval of the May-June 2025 minutes.

V. Purpose of SAC

- SAC exists to engage parents, staff, and community members in school improvement and student achievement.
- Meetings focus on reviewing school initiatives, discussing academic and social-emotional goals, and voting on the use of funds.

VI. Principal Reports/Updates

Principal Dailey shared:

- New Initiatives:

- Launch of the SOAR Store, a schoolwide positive behavior system where students earn ClassDojo points for behavior, attendance, and academics,

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redeemable for rewards.

- **Introduction of mentoring programs:** Sanders Park is now an official 5000 Role Models site (Mr. McIntosh & Ms. Desire as site directors). A girls' mentoring and service program will also launch.

- Academic Updates:

- Sanders Park Elementary earned an "A" rating for the second consecutive year.

- **ELA:** Lower quartile ELA learning gains increased by 19 percentage points (6th highest in the region).

- **Math:** Gains increased in grades 3 and 4; all retained 3rd graders made learning gains.

- **Subgroups:** All ESSA subgroups (ESE, ESOL, FRL, Hispanic, Black, White) performed above state thresholds.

- **IND Cluster Program:** Students exceeded expectations, raising the school's projected grade.

- Areas for Growth:

- 5th grade math learning gains declined.

- Less than half of 5th graders were proficient in science.

- 2nd grade ELA and primary math showed declines.

- School Goals 2025–26: Increase overall school points to 585, strengthening "A" rating.

VII. School Improvement Plan

- Focus on 5th grade math and science proficiency, improving primary literacy and numeracy, and continuing subgroup achievement gains.

VIII. Accountability Funds

- Funds are designated for extended learning opportunities, materials, and teacher training.

- Budget balances are pending; updates will be shared at the next SAC meeting.

IX. SESIR (School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting)

- No new incidents were reported during this meeting.

X. Title I

- **Presented by Ms. Whyte, Title I Liaison:**

- Title I provides federal funding to support extended learning, tutoring, and

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resources.

- Parents must complete Free & Reduced Lunch applications by September 23rd to ensure continued eligibility.
- Ms. Morales is available to assist parents with applications and Focus account setup.

XII. New Business

a. Voting for SAC Composition.

The SAC Composition was presented during the meeting. It was noted that nominations for parents, teachers, and community/business partners took place prior to this initial meeting. Following the completion of the nominations, the SAC Chair brought the motion to the floor to vote on the SAC Composition. Ms. Davis stated, "I move to vote on the SAC Composition." The motion was seconded by Ms. Hylton, who stated, "I second the motion to vote on the SAC Composition." The SAC Chair restated the motion, saying, "It has been moved and seconded that the SAC Composition be approved as presented." The motion was then brought to the floor for a vote, and upon the Chair's call for "All in favor, say 'yea,'" all members responded in favor. The motion passed unanimously, and the SAC Composition was approved.

b. Nominations

Nominations for SAC officers were presented during the meeting. Sophia Dessources was nominated for SAC Chair, Brielle Davis was nominated for SAC Secretary, and Leslie Harden was nominated for I-Zone Representative. The SAC Chair brought the motion to the floor to induct the nominees into their respective positions as presented. Ms. Dansby stated, "I move to have Sophia Dessources, Brielle Davis, and Leslie Harden inducted into the positions that were mentioned." The motion was seconded by Ms. Robinson, who stated, "I second the motion to induct the nominees into their respective positions." The Chair restated the motion, saying, "It has been moved and seconded that the nominees—Sophia Dessources as SAC Chair, Brielle Davis as SAC Secretary, and Leslie Harden as I-Zone Representative—be inducted into their respective offices." The motion was brought to the floor for a vote, and upon the Chair's call for "All in favor, say 'yea,'" all members responded in favor. The motion passed unanimously, and the nominees were officially inducted into their positions.

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c. Voting for SAC By-Laws.

The SAC By-Laws were presented during the meeting. It was noted that officers are elected yearly at the first meeting of the school year. Following the presentation, the SAC Chair brought the motion to the floor to vote on the SAC By-Laws. Mr. Williams stated, "I move to vote on the SAC By-Laws." The motion was seconded by Mr. Hylton, who stated, "I second the motion to vote on the SAC By-Laws." The SAC Chair restated the motion, saying, "It has been moved and seconded that the SAC By-Laws be approved as presented." The motion was then brought to the floor for a vote, and upon the Chair's call for "All in favor, say 'yea,'" all members responded in favor. The motion passed unanimously, and the SAC By-Laws were approved.


