March 25, 2026

1. Call to Order

Mrs. Campbell-Watkins called the meeting to order at 2:15PM and confirmed whether or not a quorum was present.

2. Welcome and Introductions

Mrs. Campbell-Watkins welcomed all attendees and facilitated introductions. She emphasized the importance of collaboration between school staff and families.

3. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

The previous meeting minutes were reviewed. A motion to approve was made by a Ms. Schulman and seconded by a parent. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Principal Updates – Mr. Donald Lee

Mr. Lee provided updates on key school initiatives:

- Accountability Dollars: Funds have been allocated to support instructional resources, student incentives, and technology enhancements.
- SESIR: A review of reported incidents was discussed, with a focus on maintaining a safe and supportive learning environment.

5. FAST Testing Updates

Updates were shared regarding upcoming assessments:

- Saturday Camp: Additional academic support sessions will be offered to prepare students for FAST testing.
- Varsity Tutoring: Targeted tutoring sessions are ongoing to support students needing additional intervention. This is take place twice a week during student specials.

6. Survey Results Review – Ms. Bradshaw

Ms. Bradshaw reviewed survey data collected from parents, staff, and students. Overall feedback was positive, with noted areas for growth in communication and parent engagement.

7. Parent and Family Engagement

Discussion focused on increasing parent participation through events, workshops, and improved communication strategies. Suggestions included flexible meeting times and more family-centered activities.

8. School Improvement Plan (SIP) Updates – Ms. Bradshaw

Updates were provided on progress toward SIP goals. Focus areas include increasing student achievement in reading and math, and strengthening instructional practices.

9. Parent Involvement Allocation (Budget Discussion) – Ms. Bradshaw

The allocation of funds for parent involvement activities was reviewed. Proposed expenditures included family engagement events, resources, and workshops.

10. School-Parent Compact Review – Ms. Bradshaw

The School-Parent Compact was reviewed. Feedback was gathered to ensure alignment with current school goals and expectations.

11. New Business – Mrs. Campbell-Watkins

Mrs. Campbell-Watkins opened the floor for new topics. Discussion included upcoming school events and opportunities for increased community partnerships.

12. Open Forum / Questions

Attendees asked questions regarding testing, tutoring opportunities, and ways to support students at home. Responses were provided by school staff.







13. Adjournment
