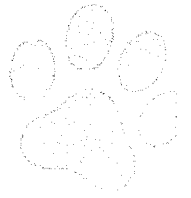

**Call to Order**

The joint SAC & SAF meeting was called to order by Mrs. Campbell-Watkins. Members and attendees were welcomed, and introductions were made. Mr. Lee thanked all staff, parents, and community members for attending and supporting the continued success of Cresthaven Elementary School.

**Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes**

Ms. Campbell-Watkins presented the minutes from the previous SAC/SAF meeting for review. Members were given an opportunity to ask questions or request corrections.

A motion was made to approve the previous meeting minutes as presented. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously by the council members present.

**Principal Updates**

Mr. Lee provided several important school updates and shared information regarding school operations, student support, and planning for the upcoming school year.

**SESIR Updates**

Mr. Lee reported that there were no SESIR incidents reported during the current reporting period. He commended staff and students for maintaining a safe and positive school environment and emphasized the importance of continuing proactive behavioral supports and positive school culture initiatives.

## **Accountability Funds**

The council reviewed the remaining accountability fund balance of **\$38.83**. Mr. Lee explained that previous accountability funds were utilized to purchase student instructional resources and support the acquisition of a Promethean Board to enhance classroom instruction and student engagement.

Members discussed the positive impact instructional technology and student resources have had on classroom learning and student participation.

## **2026–2027 School Budget Presentation**

Mr. Lee presented information regarding the projected budget and staffing plans for the 2026–2027 school year.

## **Enrollment Projection**

Projected student enrollment for the upcoming school year is expected to be approximately **478 students**. Discussion included how enrollment numbers impact staffing allocations, classroom sizes, and instructional support services.

## **Project Allocation and Staffing**

Mr. Lee shared that Cresthaven Elementary will have **three bilingual paraprofessionals** on staff during the 2026–2027 school year to support communication and student needs within the school community. The languages represented will include:

- Haitian Creole
- Spanish
- Portuguese

Members discussed how bilingual support staff will strengthen communication with families and provide additional academic and social support for multilingual learners.

## **Special Programs**

Mr. Lee reviewed the special programs that will continue to be offered at Cresthaven Elementary, including:

- Head Start
- VPK
- Pre-K Intensive

- Pre-K Specialized

The council discussed the importance of maintaining early childhood and specialized programs to support student readiness and individualized learning needs.

### **Instructional Support**

Discussion was held regarding instructional support that will continue to be implemented schoolwide to improve student achievement and academic growth. Mr. Lee highlighted the school's commitment to intervention support, differentiated instruction, and providing resources to teachers and students.

### **Questions and Open Discussion**

Parents and community members were provided the opportunity to ask questions and share feedback regarding school programs, student support services, staffing, and schoolwide initiatives.

Discussion topics included:

- Continued academic intervention support for struggling students
- Communication between school and families
- Support for multilingual families
- Student enrollment and class sizes for the upcoming school year

Mr. Lee addressed questions and thanked parents for their continued involvement and partnership.

### **SAF Updates**

Karina Jimenez provided SAF updates and discussed parent and community concerns. Topics included family engagement opportunities, strengthening community partnerships, and encouraging parent participation in school events and committees.

Parents were encouraged to continue providing feedback and participating in school improvement efforts throughout the school year.




