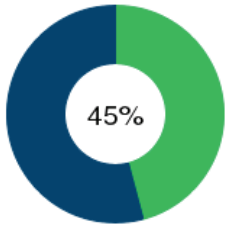

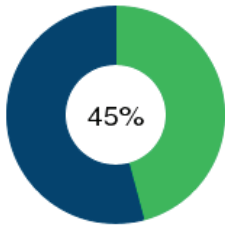

Call to Order:

An in-person meeting was held by the Stephen Foster Elementary School Advisory Council on **Monday, December 8, 2025**. Jessica Koppel called the meeting to order at 6:06 pm. Lindsey Griner seconds this motion. Lindsey Griner will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

Diana Vigo motioned to propose the purchase of Scholastic Word for grades Stephen Foster Elementary School. The total of the purchase includes \$1,371.00. 9 out of 16 people motioned to approve this proposal. Motion approved unanimously. The 9 SAC members that voted "yay" to pass the motion include Melany Alvarenga, Ricky Grimaldo, Lindsey Griner, Jessica Koppel, Erin McDonough, Veronica Medina, Matt Milner, Yavonna Silvera, and Diana Vigo.

Ms. Koppel reviews the meeting agenda beginning with an overview of what the Florida School Recognition Program is. The process of implementing options for the allocation of funds is to be successfully completed by February 1, 2026 for all schools that qualify. The use of the recognition awards can be used for one or any combination of the following: Nonrecurring bonuses to faculty and

staff; nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment or materials to assist in maintaining and improving student performance; or temporary personnel for the school to assist in maintaining and improving student performance. The Florida School Recognition funds awarded to Stephen Foster Elementary include a total of \$44,466 and a total of \$3,944, in Fringe Benefit District Reserve.

Teachers and parents provided input to what allocations of funds they preferred. A teacher, Diana Vigo suggested that 99% of the funds should be allocated back to staff bonuses. A parent, Matt Milner asked if we had needs for major school purchases with equipment. Ricky Grimaldo stated no there wasn't a major need. Erin McDonough stated that 1% of the funds could go to the school towards educational equipment or materials.

Diana Vigo motioned to propose that 99% of the funds will be used for a one-time bonus to be divided amongst all the faculty and staff on the 2024-2025 staff roster. Staff must have worked at least half of the school year. 1% of the funds will go to the school to be allocated for nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment or materials. Jessica Koppel seconded the motion.

Motion for proposal was passed with 9 out of 16 SAC members. This proposal will be listed as Option 1 on the Stephen Foster Elementary School Florida Recognition Program Ballot. The 9 SAC members that voted "yay" to pass the motion include Melany Alvarenga, Ricky Grimaldo, Lindsey Griner, Jessica Koppel, Erin McDonough, Veronica Medina, Matt Milner, Yavonna Silvera, and Diana Vigo.

Teachers and parents discussed formulating a second option which included more funds allocated to nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment or materials.

Ricky Grimaldo, principal, motioned to propose 97% of the funds will be used for a one-time bonus to be divided equally amongst all the faculty and staff on the 2024-2025 staff roster. Staff must have worked at least half of the school year. 3% of the funds will go to the school to be allocated for nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment or materials. Any leftover A+ funds will be used for nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment or materials. Lindsey Griner seconded the motion.

Motion for proposal was passed with 9 out of 16 SAC members. This proposal will be listed as Option 2 on the Stephen Foster Elementary School Florida Recognition Program Ballot. The 9 SAC members that voted "yay" to pass the motion include Melany Alvarenga, Ricky Grimaldo, Lindsey Griner, Jessica Koppel, Erin McDonough, Veronica Medina, Matt Milner, Yavonna Silvera, and Diana Vigo.

Ms. Koppel motioned to propose the final ballot with three options. Option 3 will state "none of the above". Lindsey Griner seconded this motion. Motion for proposal of the ballot was passed with 9 out of 16 SAC members. The 9 SAC members that voted "yay" to pass the motion include Melany Alvarenga, Ricky Grimaldo, Lindsey Griner, Jessica Koppel, Erin McDonough, Veronica Medina, Matt Milner, Yavonna Silvera, and Diana Vigo.

Ms. Koppel closed the meeting by explaining the next process that staff will be notified tomorrow, Tuesday December 9, 2025 to be provided the required three-day notice to review prior to voting.

Voting will occur on Friday, December 12, 2025, at 7:30 AM – 8:00 AM and 1:30 PM – 3:00 PM in Support Office Room 401C. One of the proposals on the Stephen Foster Elementary Florida School Recognition Program ballot must receive a majority vote of 51% of the total number of staff on the first round of voting.
