

Ms. Clarke reviewed the Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) and explained its implementation. She shared that the MTSS team collaborates with teachers to collect, analyze, and input data related to intervention groups. The team meets regularly to develop and implement plans to ensure students meet academic goals and close learning gaps.

Ms. Clarke noted that interventions are typically implemented over a 4–6 week cycle at Tier 1 and/or Tier 2 to support student learning. She also reviewed two end-of-year goals: (1) 55% of students in grades 3–5 in the lowest quartile will make academic gains and reach proficiency, and (2) by June 2026, 55% of students in grades 3–5 will demonstrate learning gains on the PM3 FAST Assessment.

She reported that current data trends are positive, and the school is on track to meet these goals. Ms. Clarke recognized the hard work of both teachers and students in achieving these outcomes and noted that the school's internal target is slightly higher.

Dr. Miller requested \$5,500 to purchase Rally & Magnetic Reading Curriculum materials for Saturday School.
